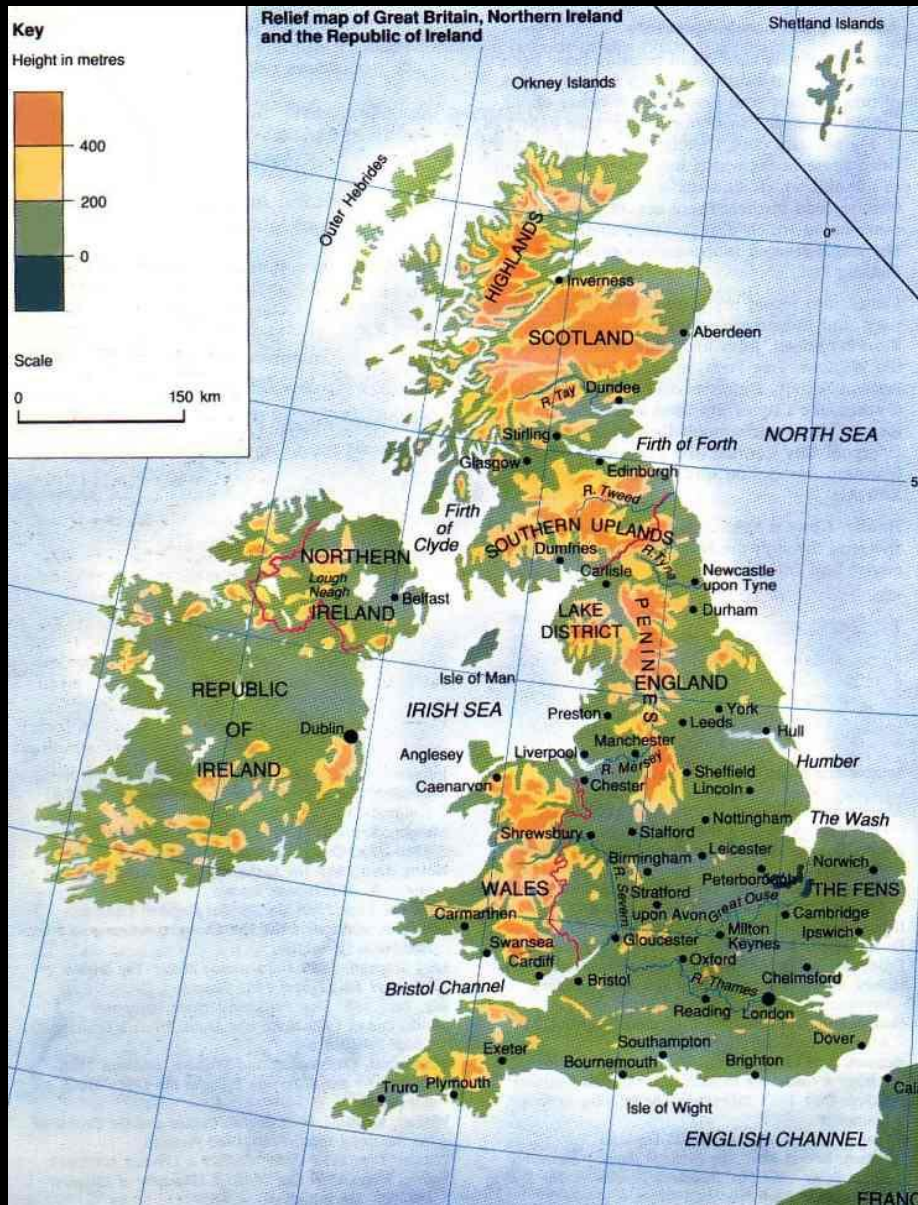




























IMPERIAL FEDERATION, MAP OF THE WORLD, SHOWING THE EXTENT OF THE BRITISH EMPIRE IN 1886.

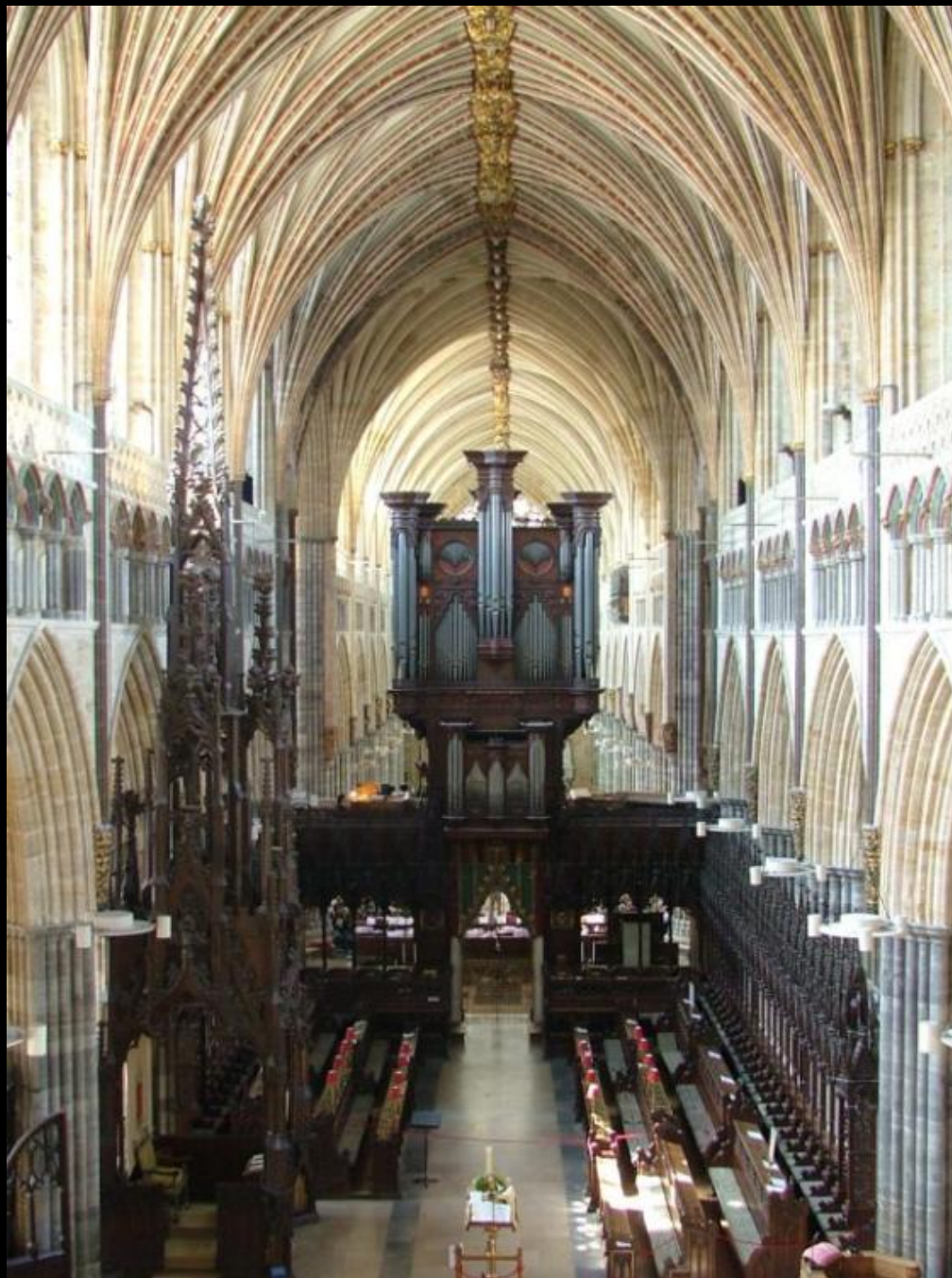


Fig.100 Exeter



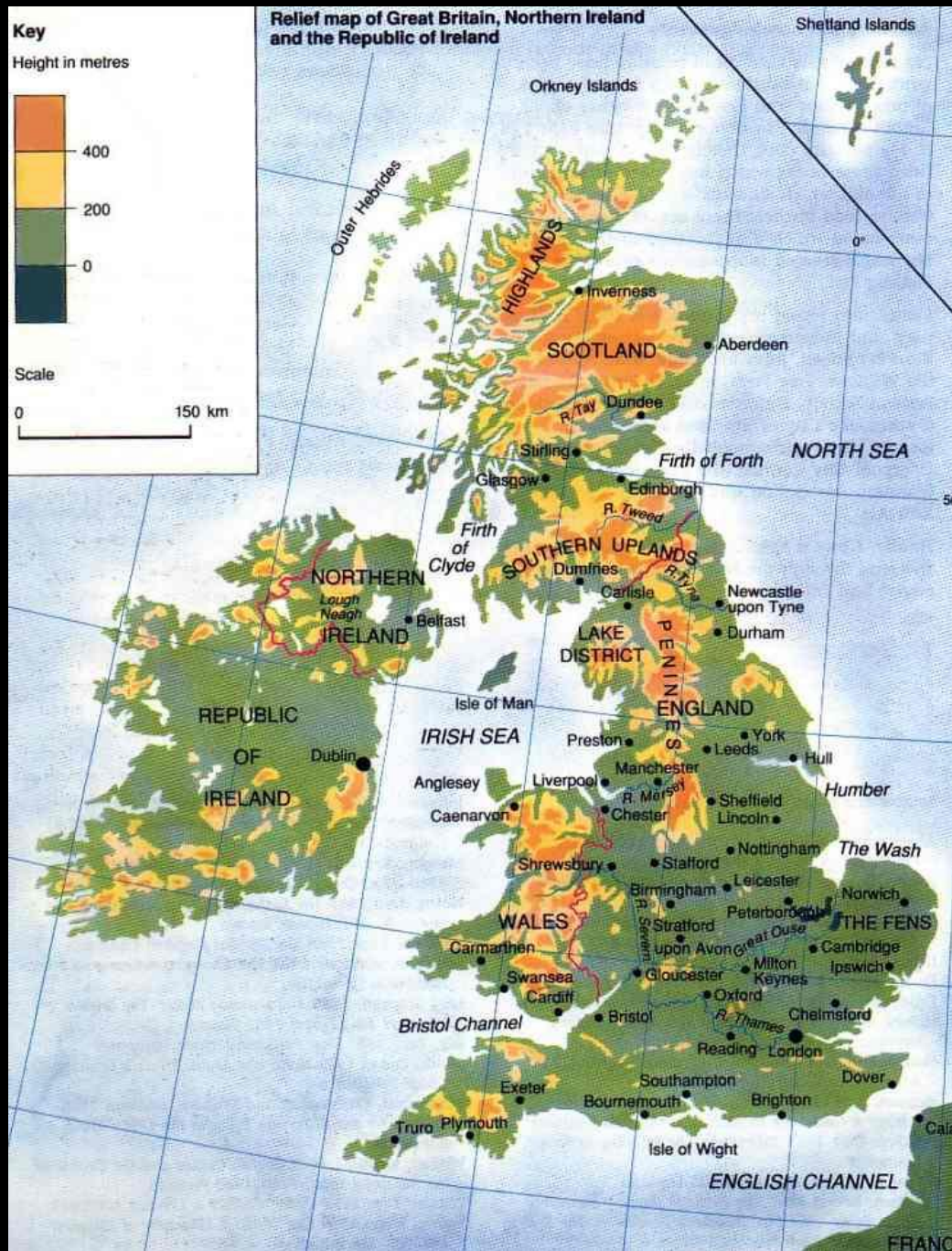
Fig.41 Dioceses in 1100















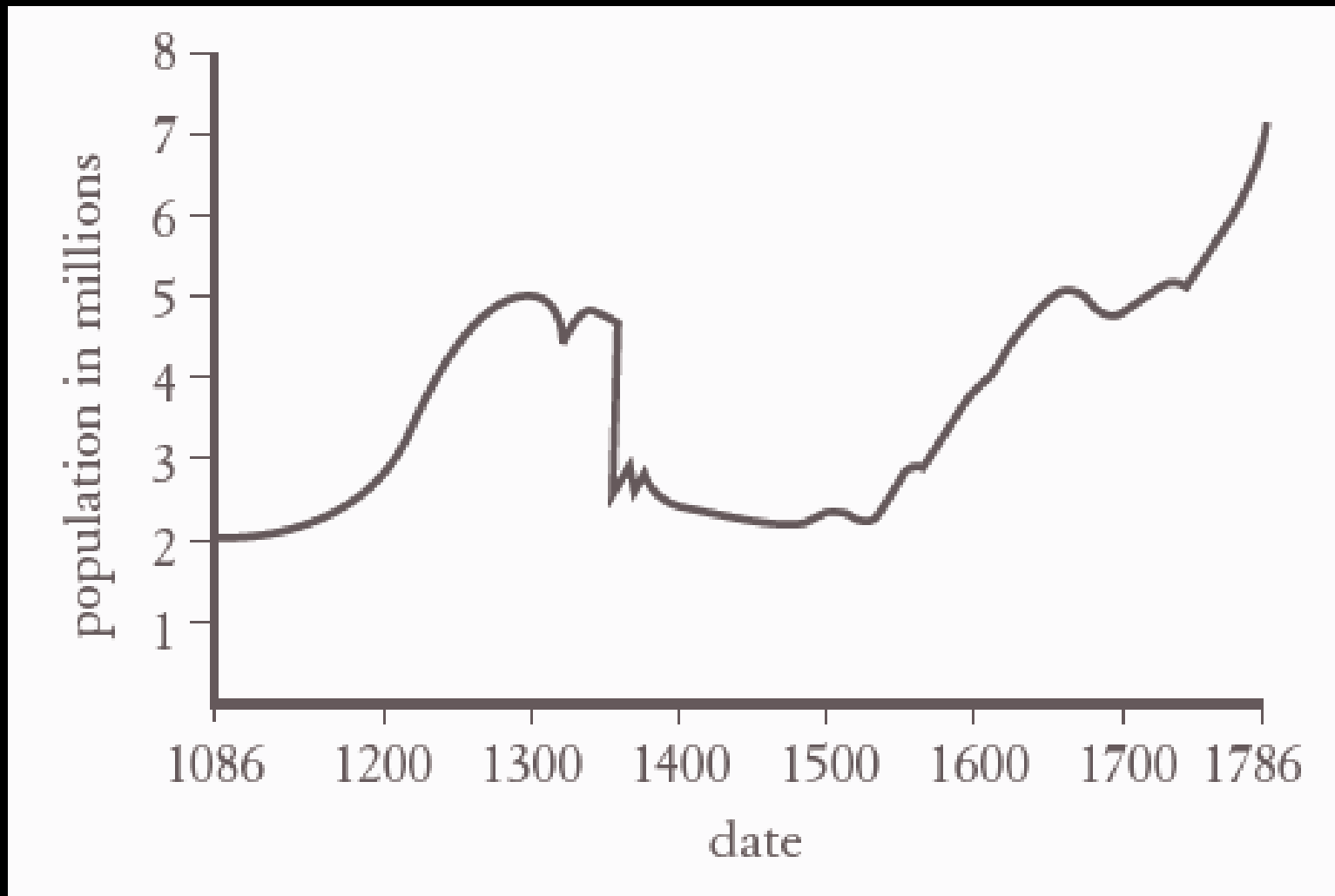
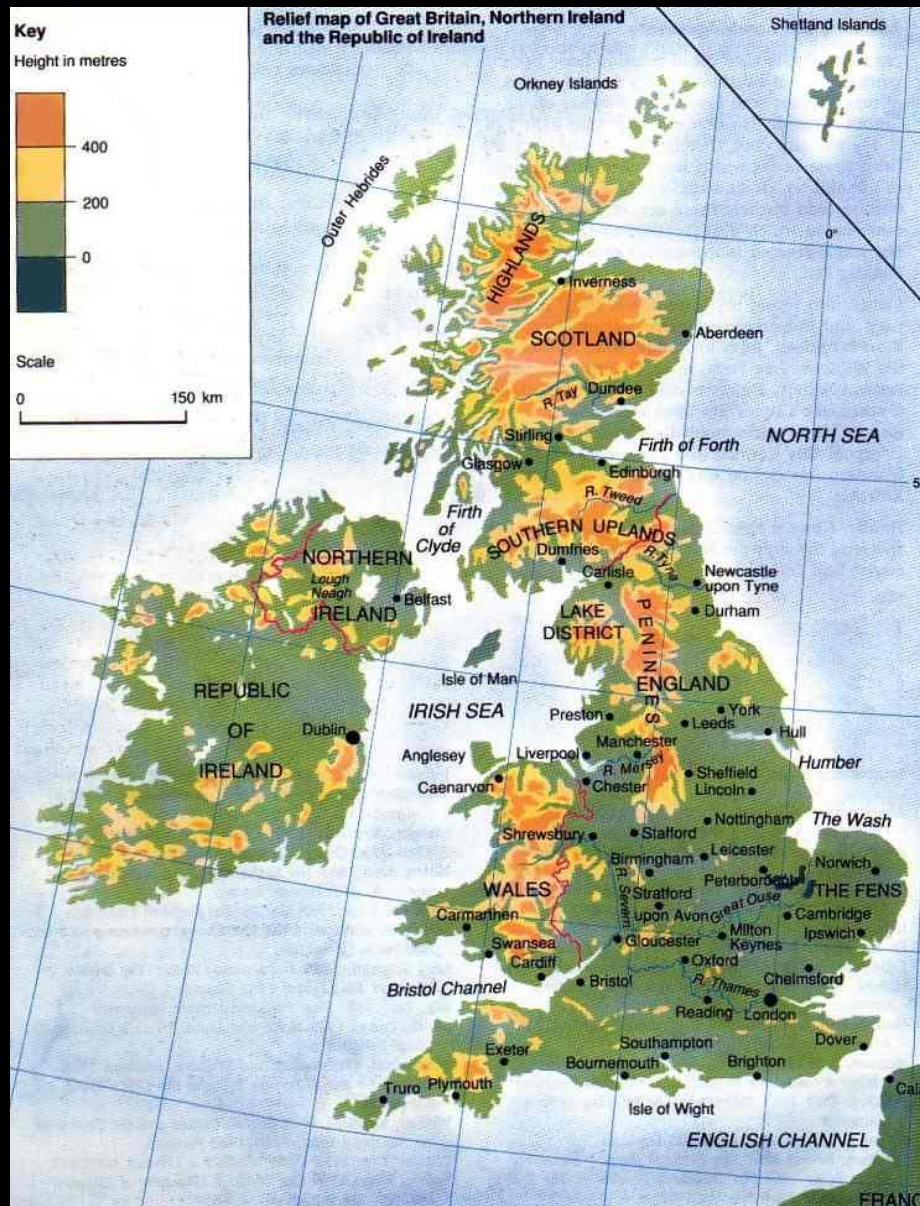


Fig.88 Population Graph













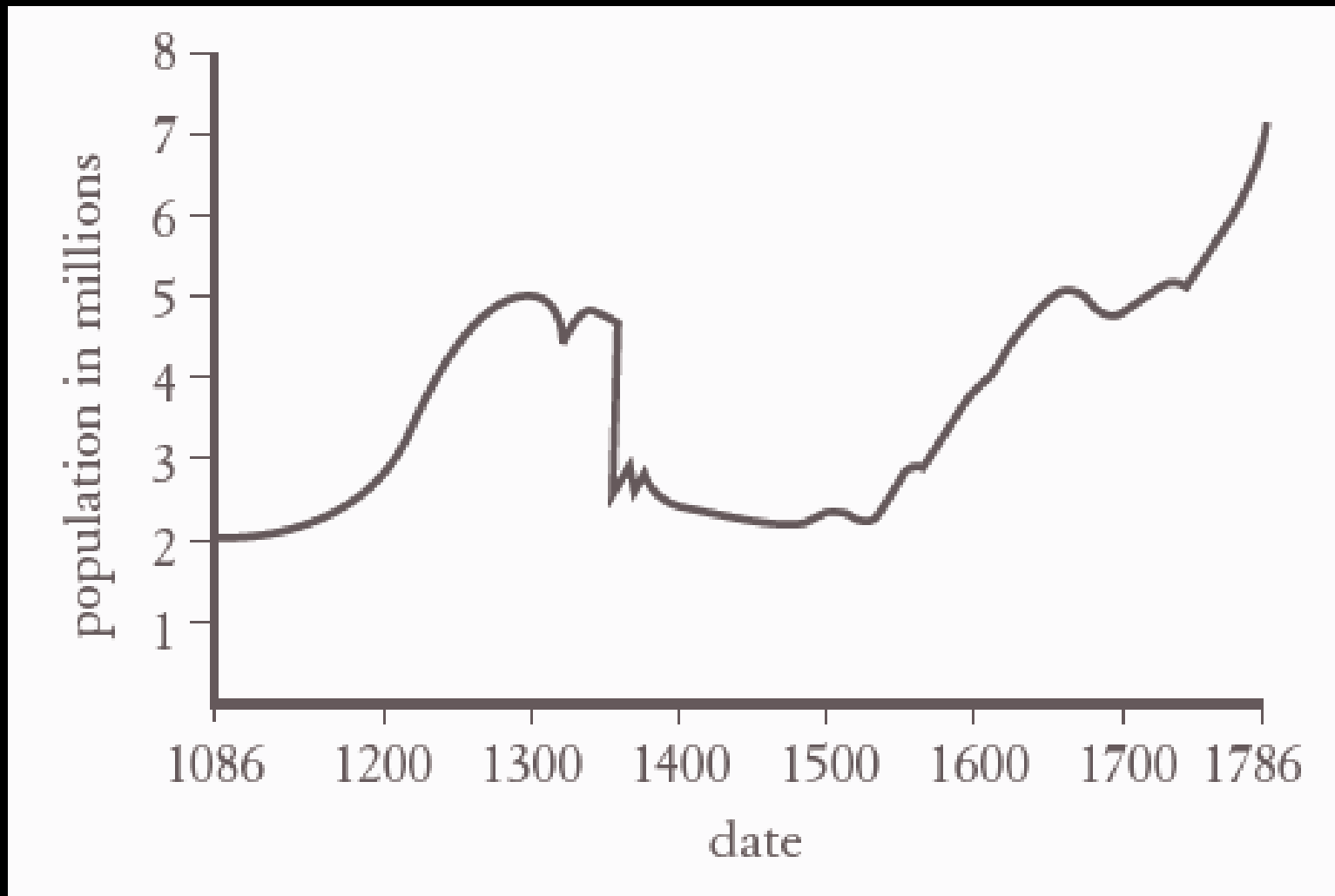


Fig.88 Population Graph

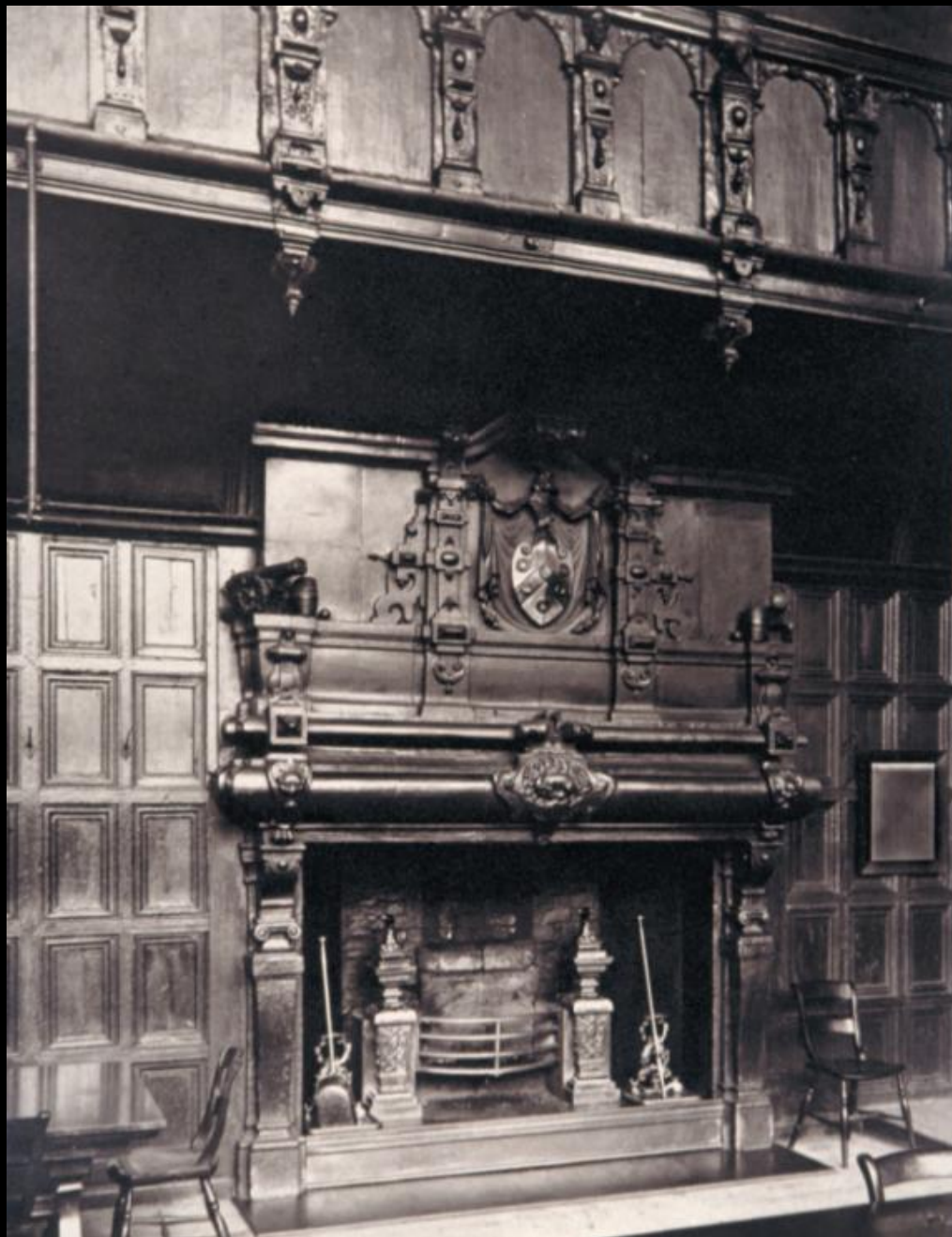
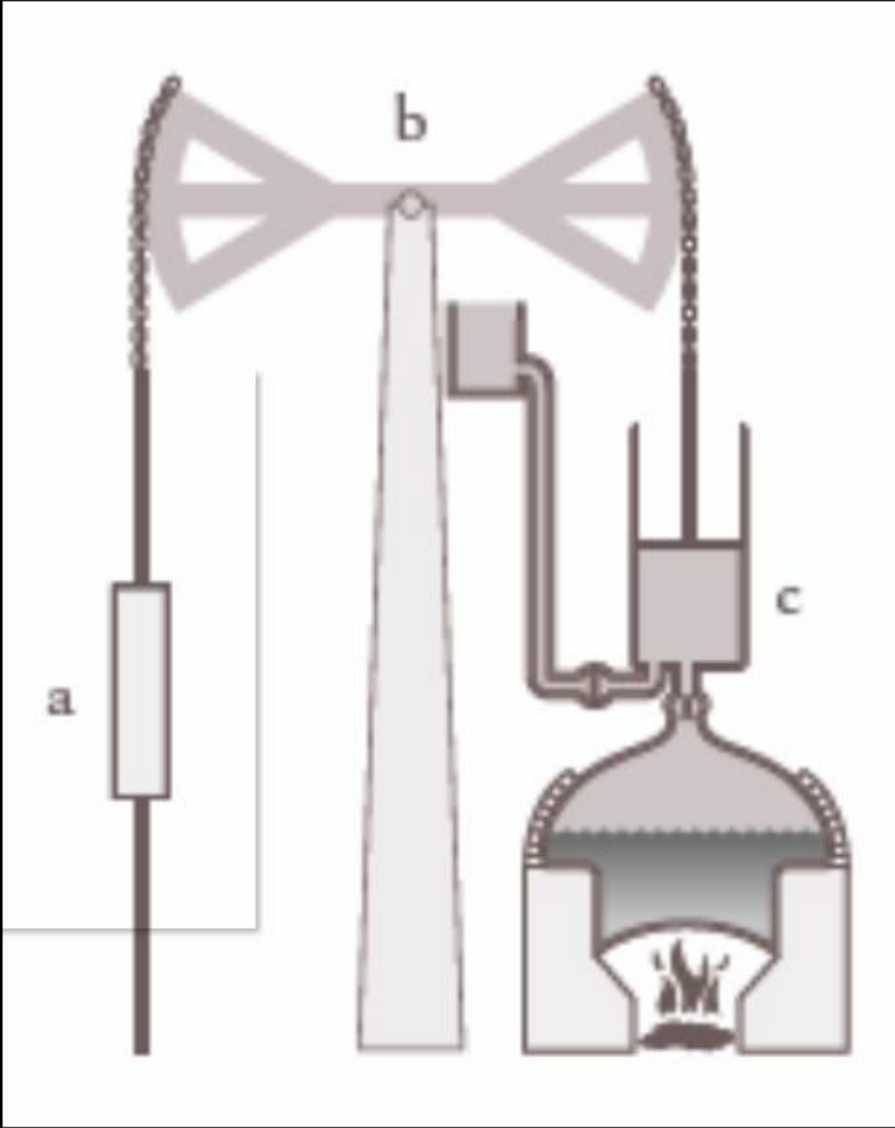


Fig.208 Charterhouse



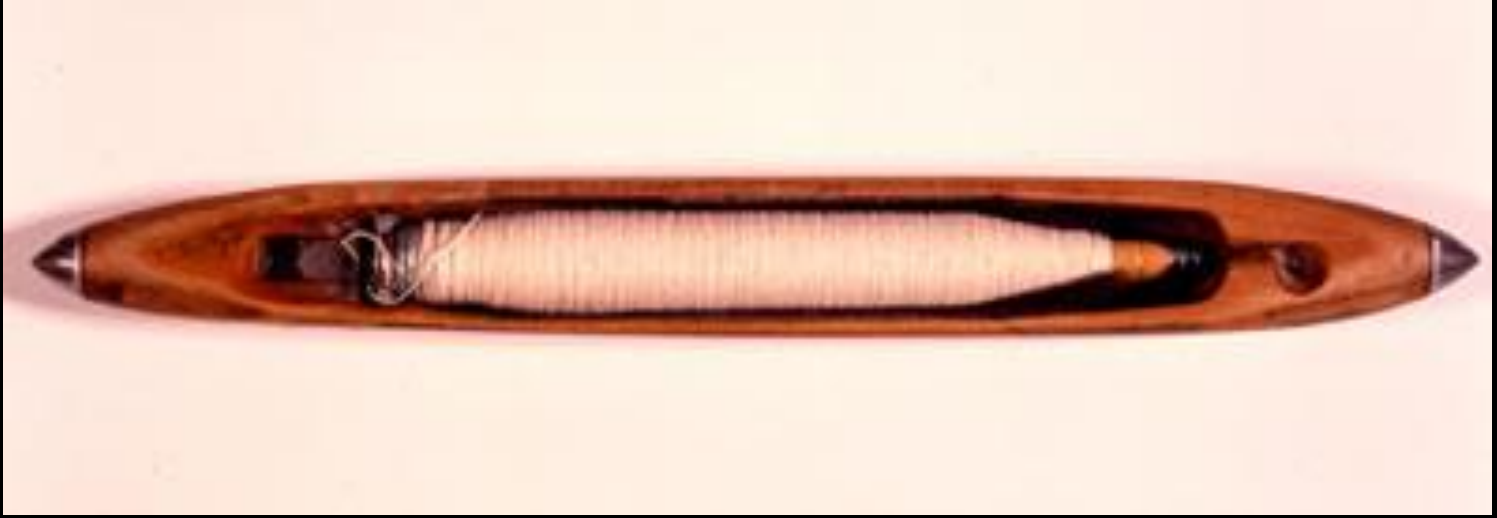


Fig.244 King's Bench Walk

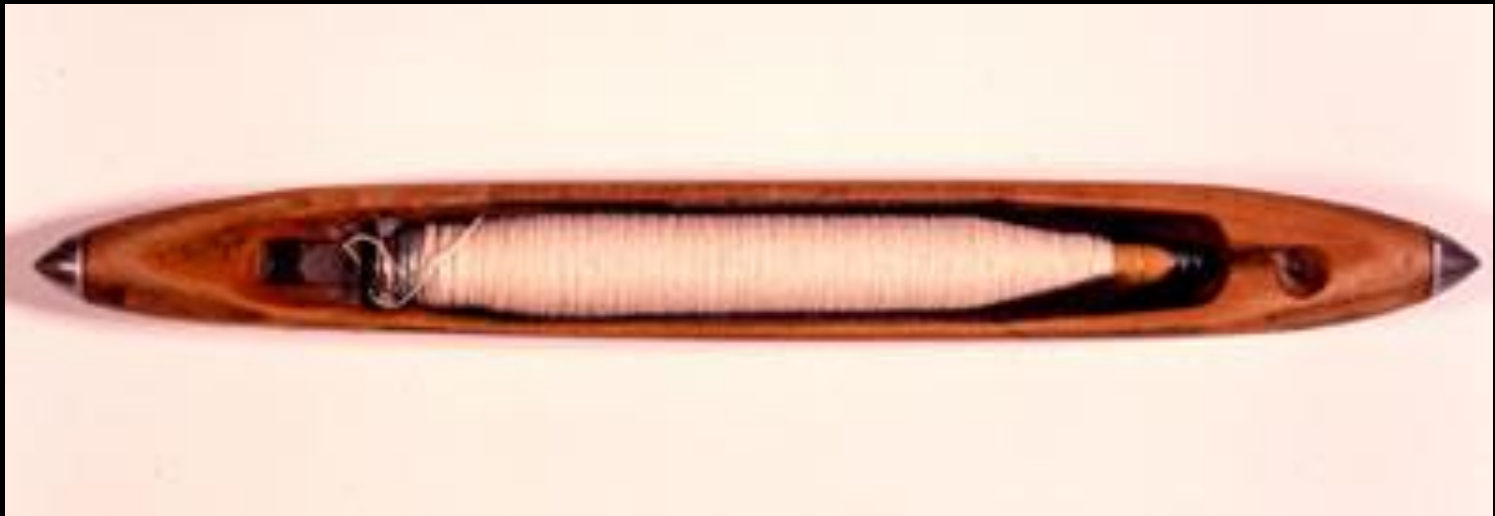
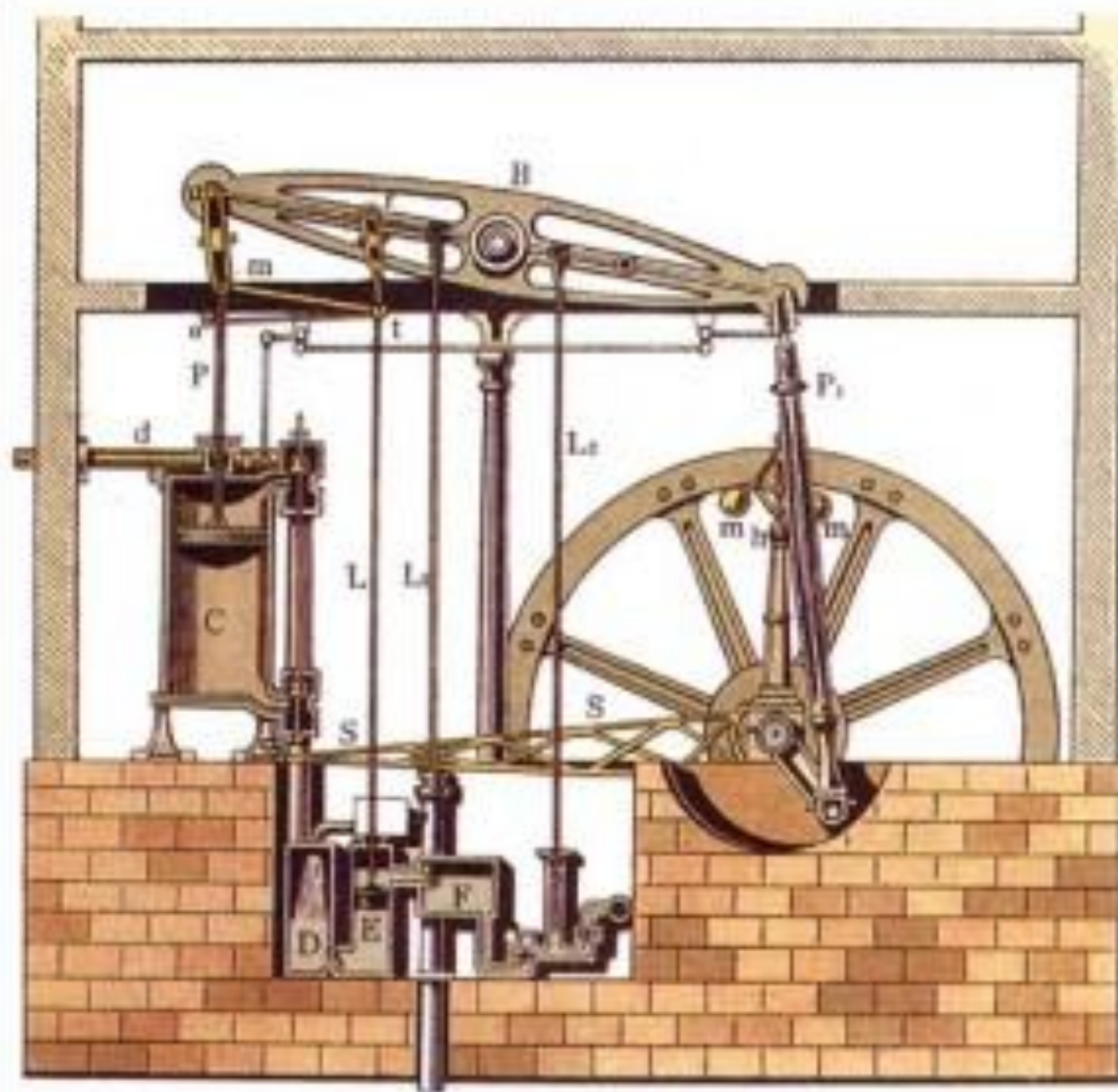






Fig.348 Cromford

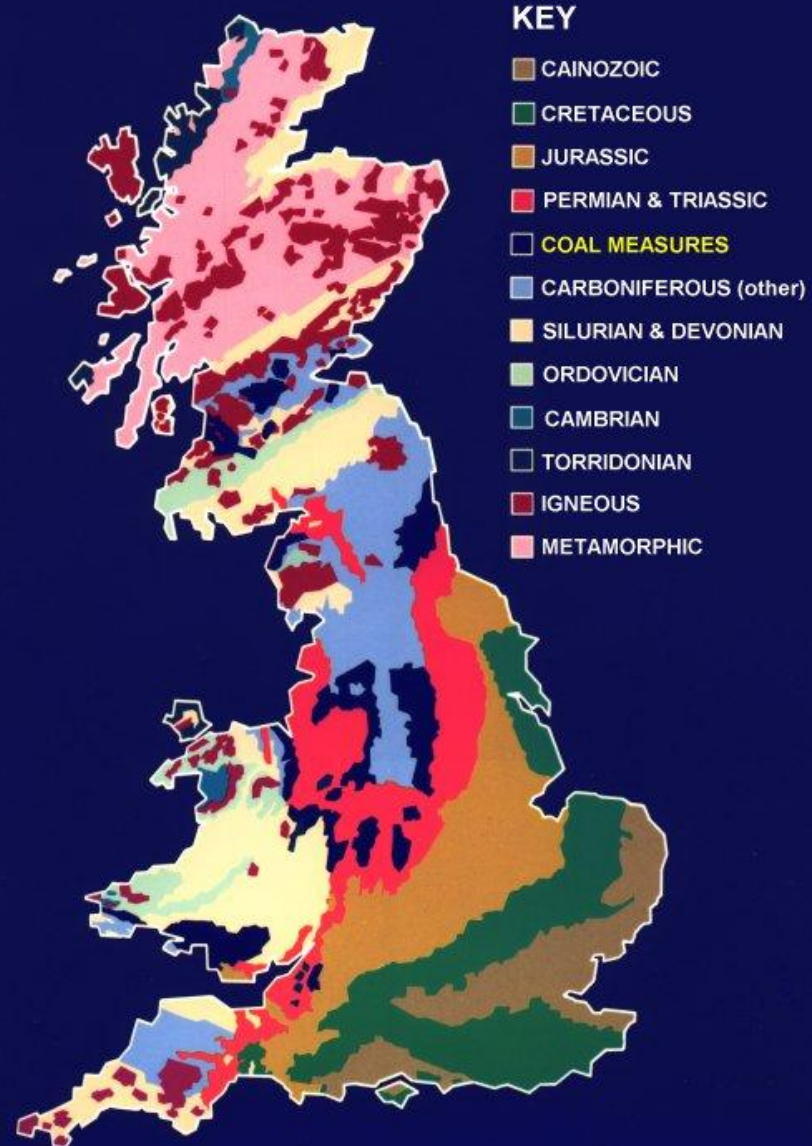






Fig.328 Bingley Five Rise

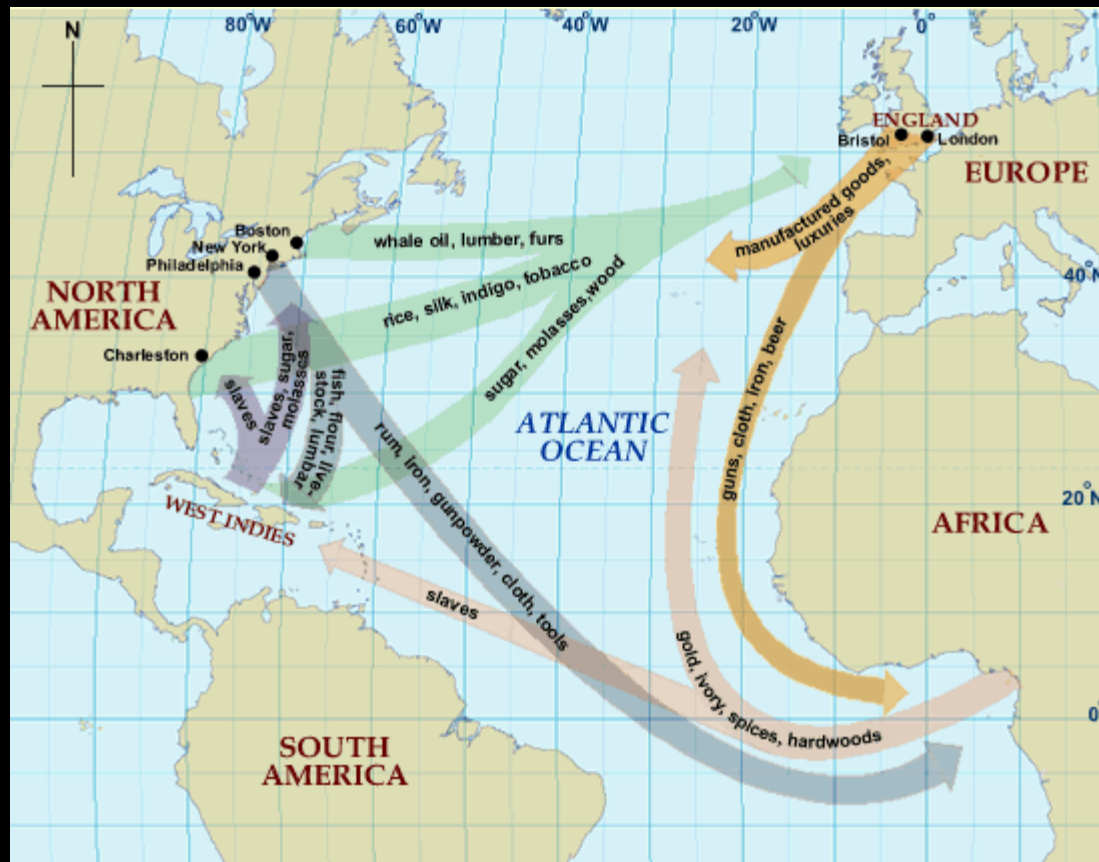




Fig.327 Albert Dock

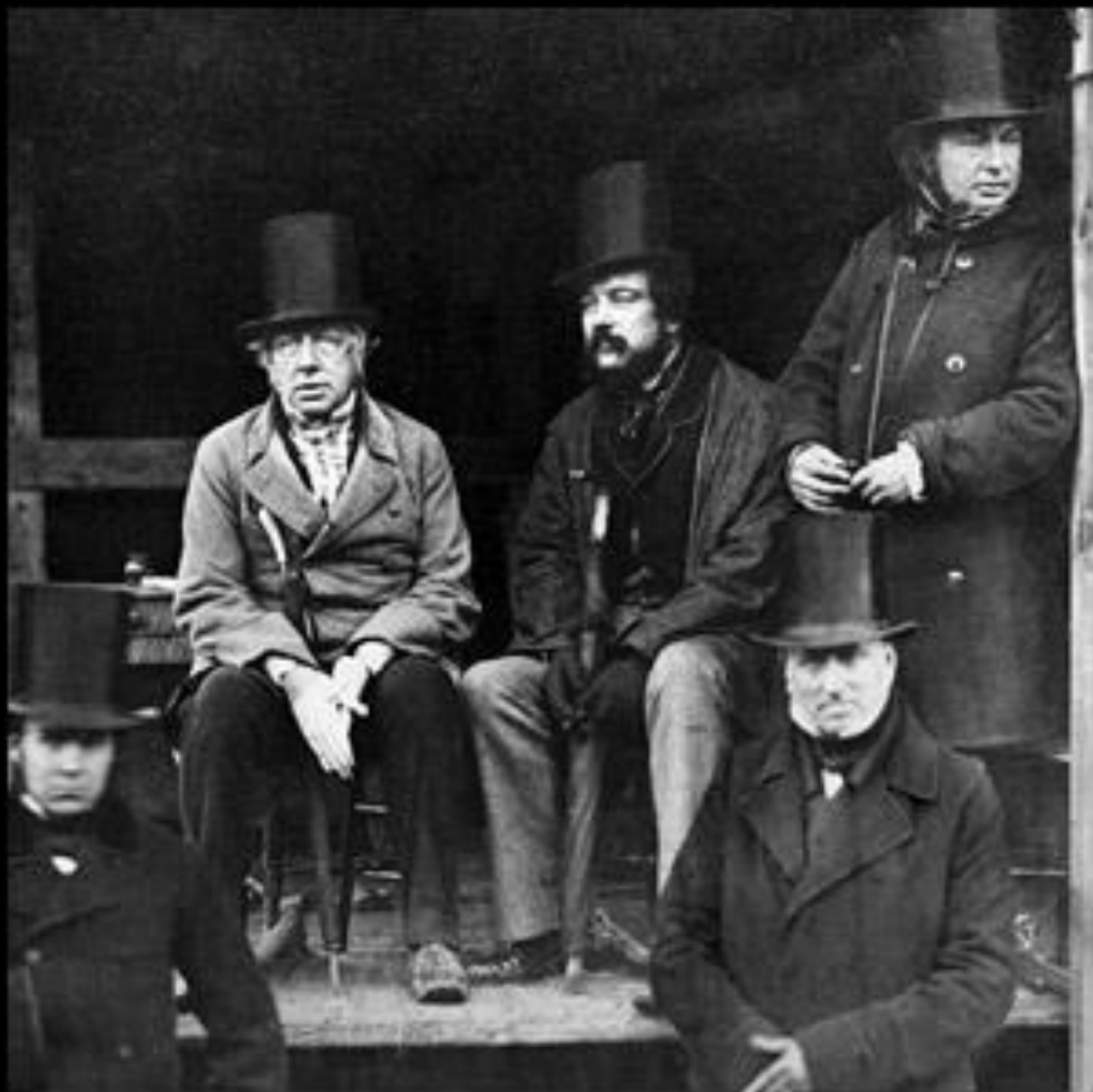




Fig.458 Charlotte Street

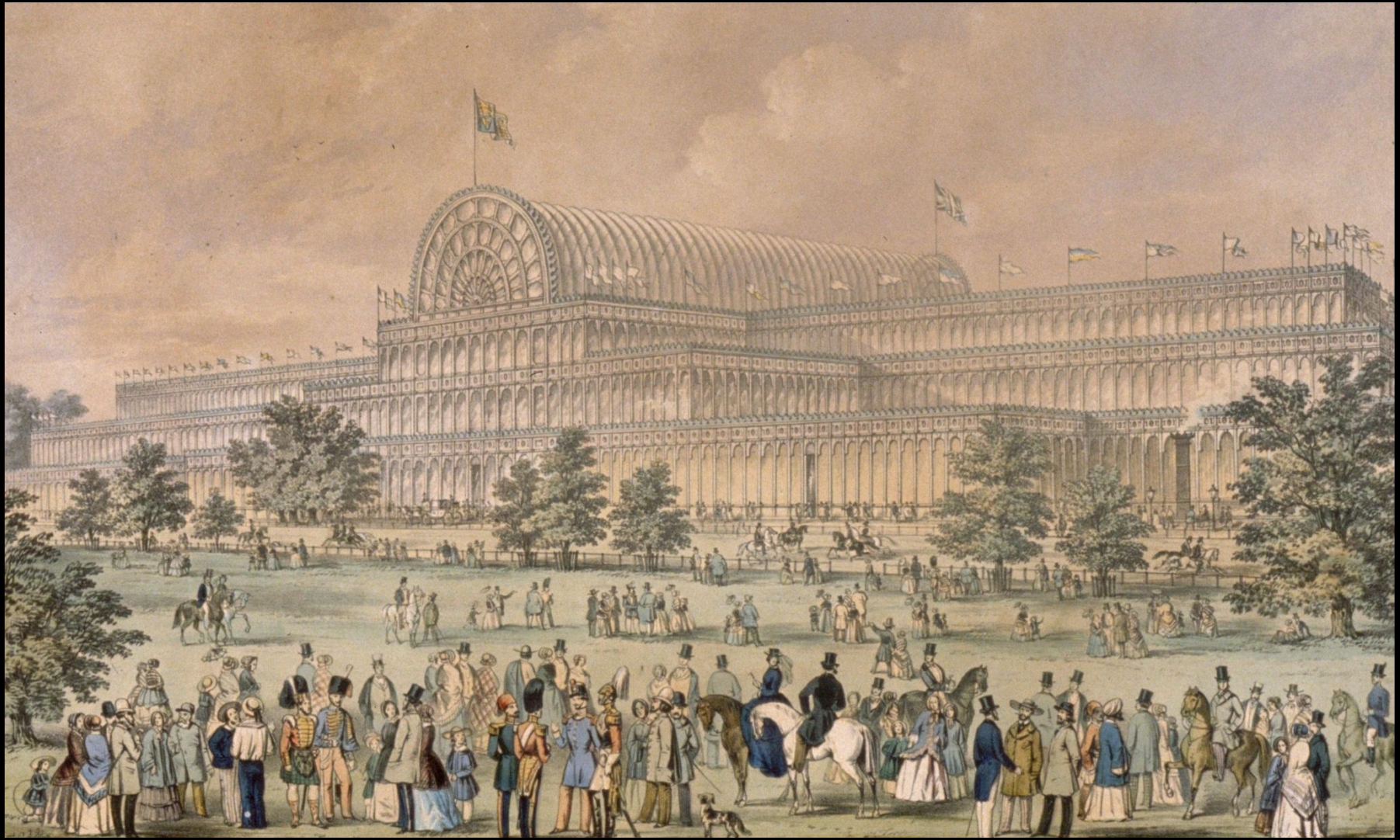






Fig.433 St Pancras, Midland Grand Hotel
