


















































A PLAN of the City and Suburbs of LONDON as fortified by Order of PARLIAMENT in the Years 1642 & 1643.























FROM PHILIP LEA'S MAP OF "LONDON AS NOW REBUILT AFTER THE LATE FIRE," c. 1673
