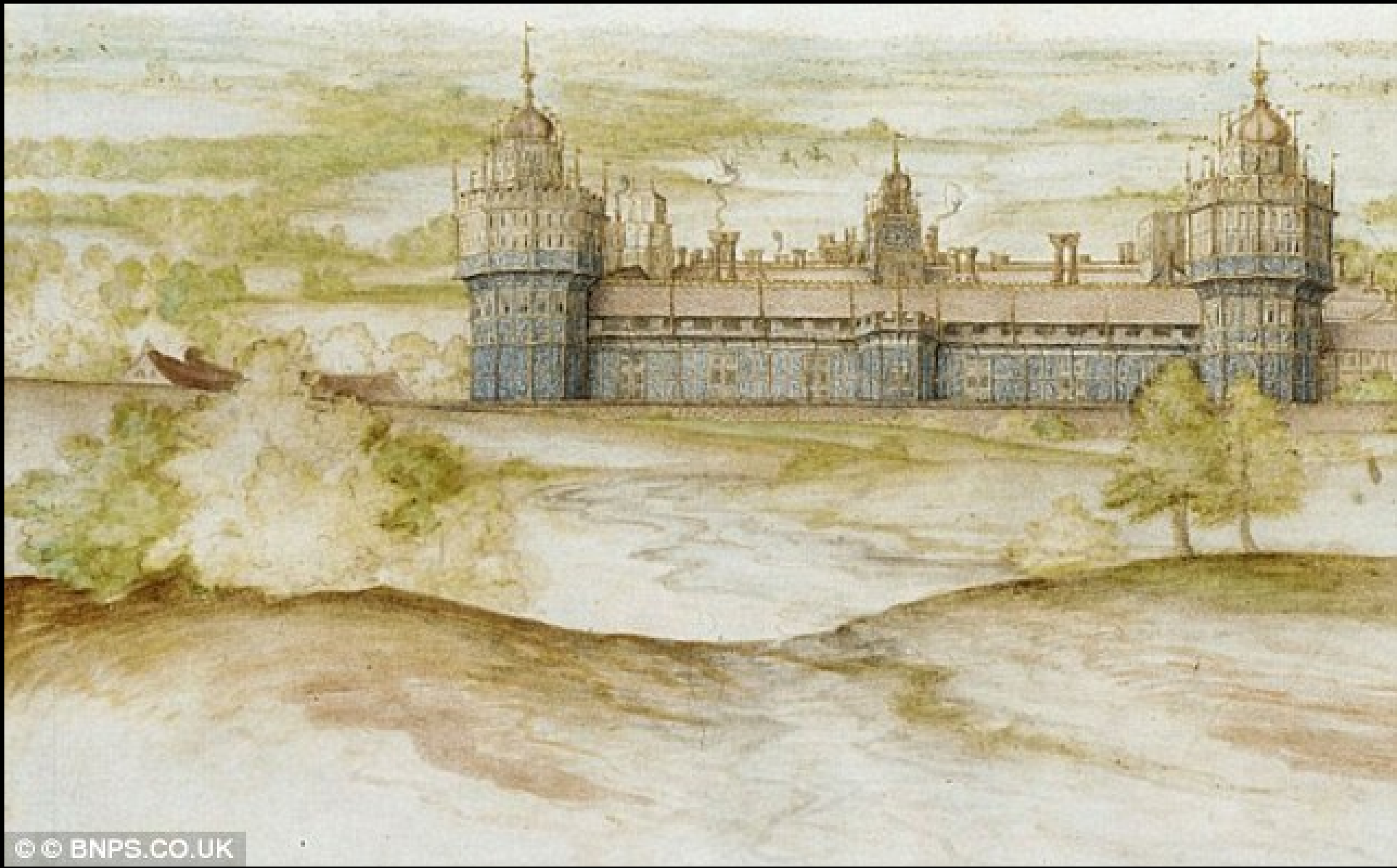

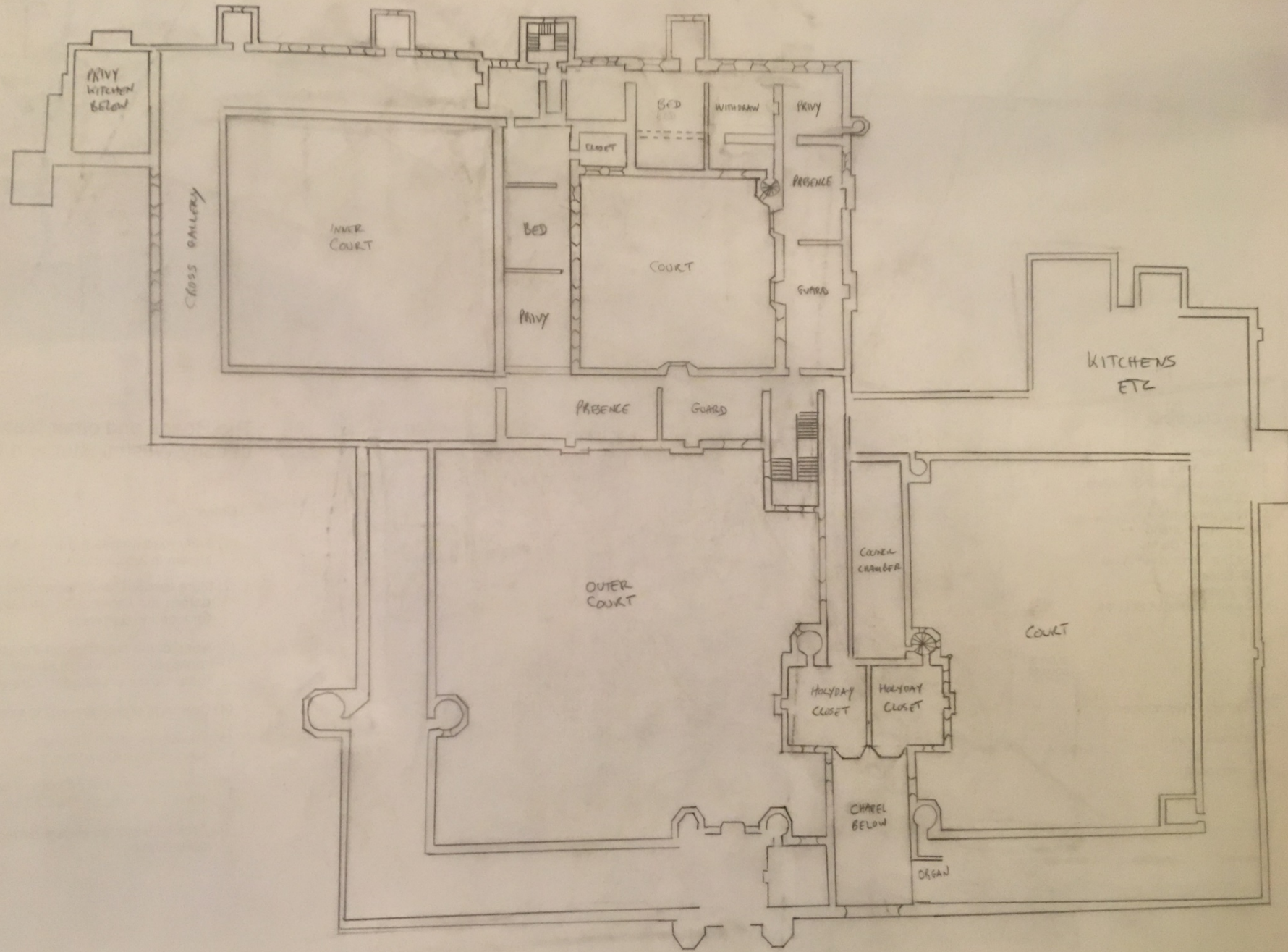


























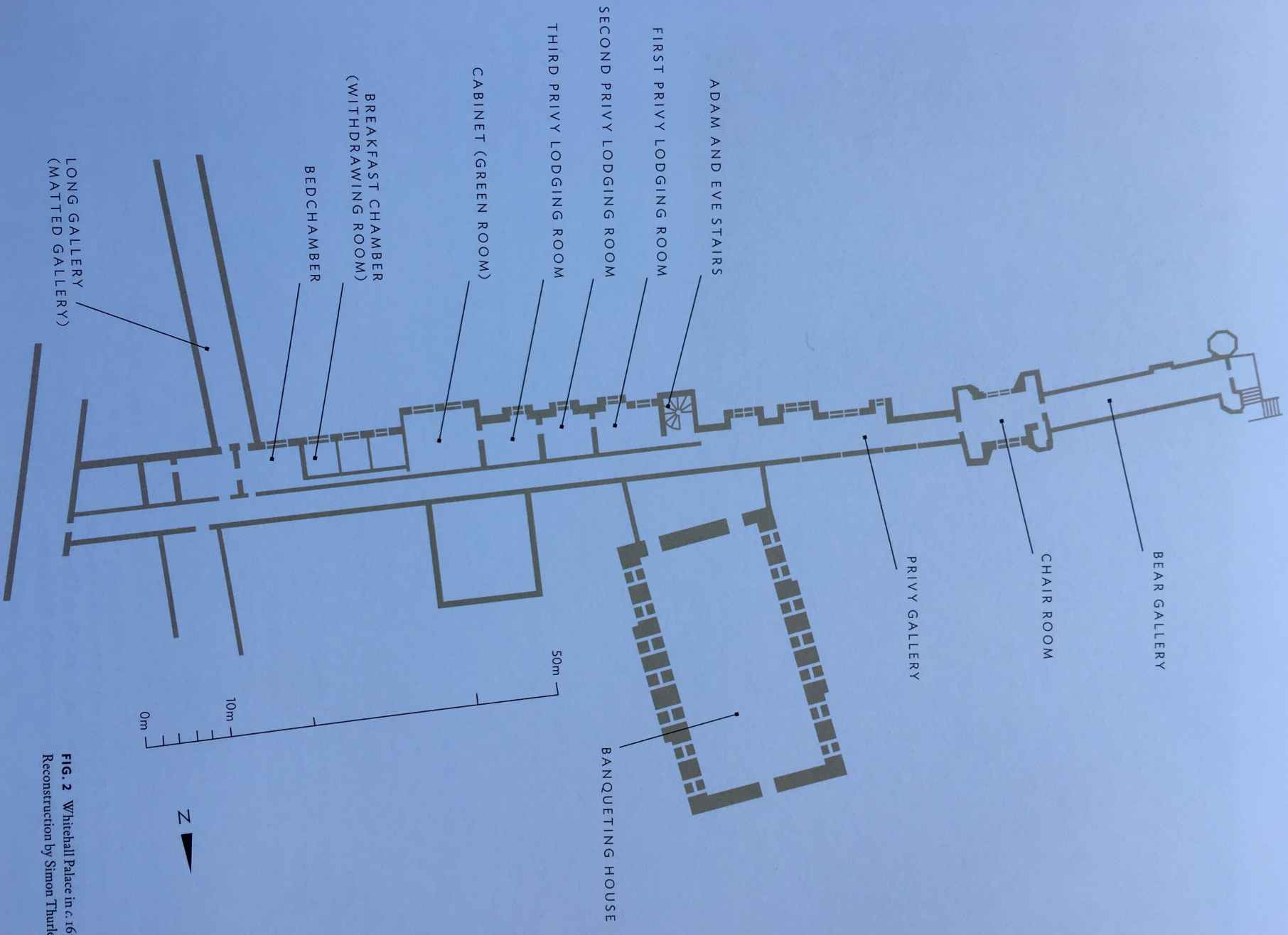


FIG. 2 Whitehall Palace in c. 1635.
 Reconstruction by Simon Thurley



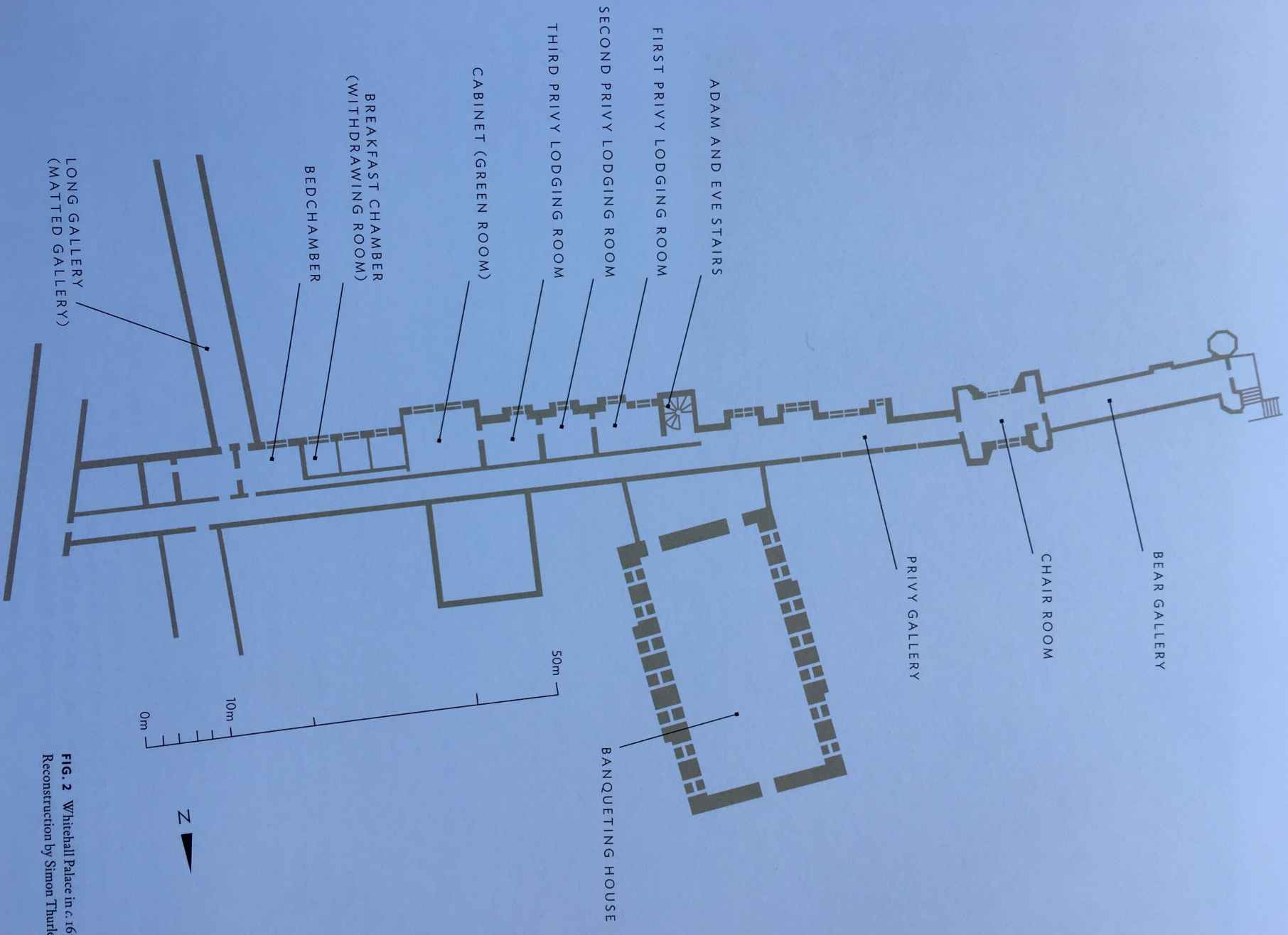


FIG. 2 Whitehall Palace in c. 1635.
 Reconstruction by Simon Thurley



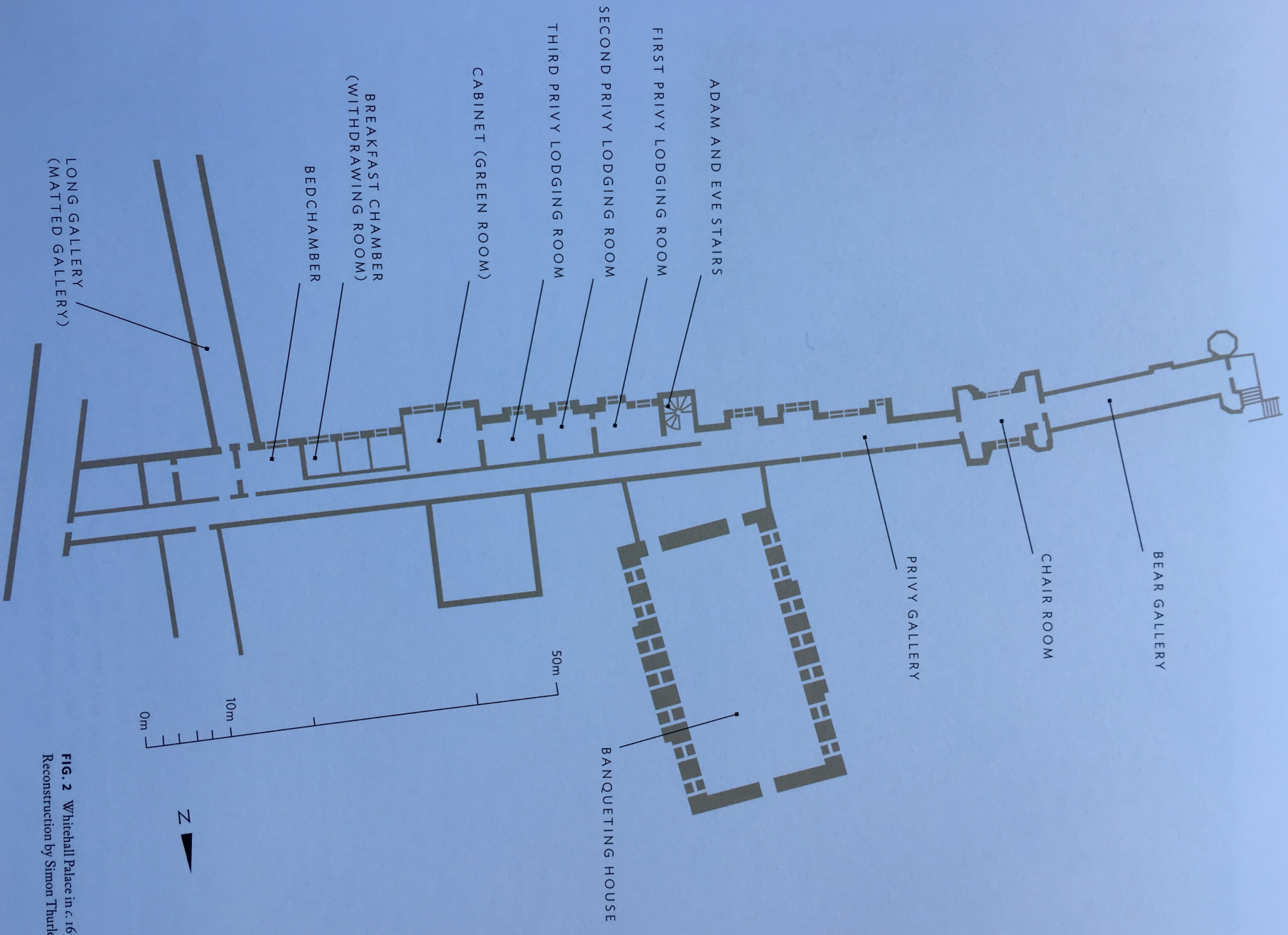


FIG. 2 Whitehall Palace in c. 1635.

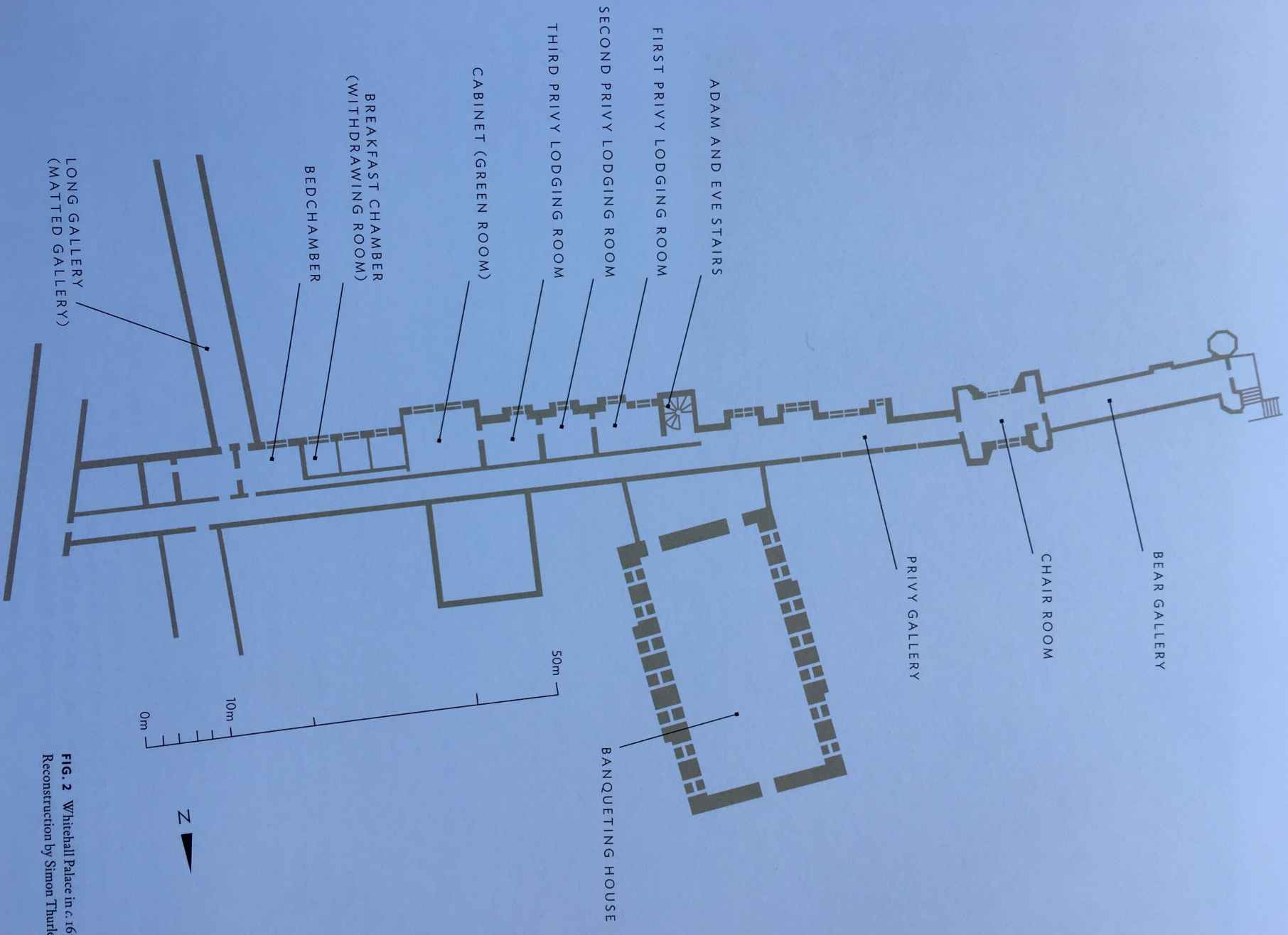
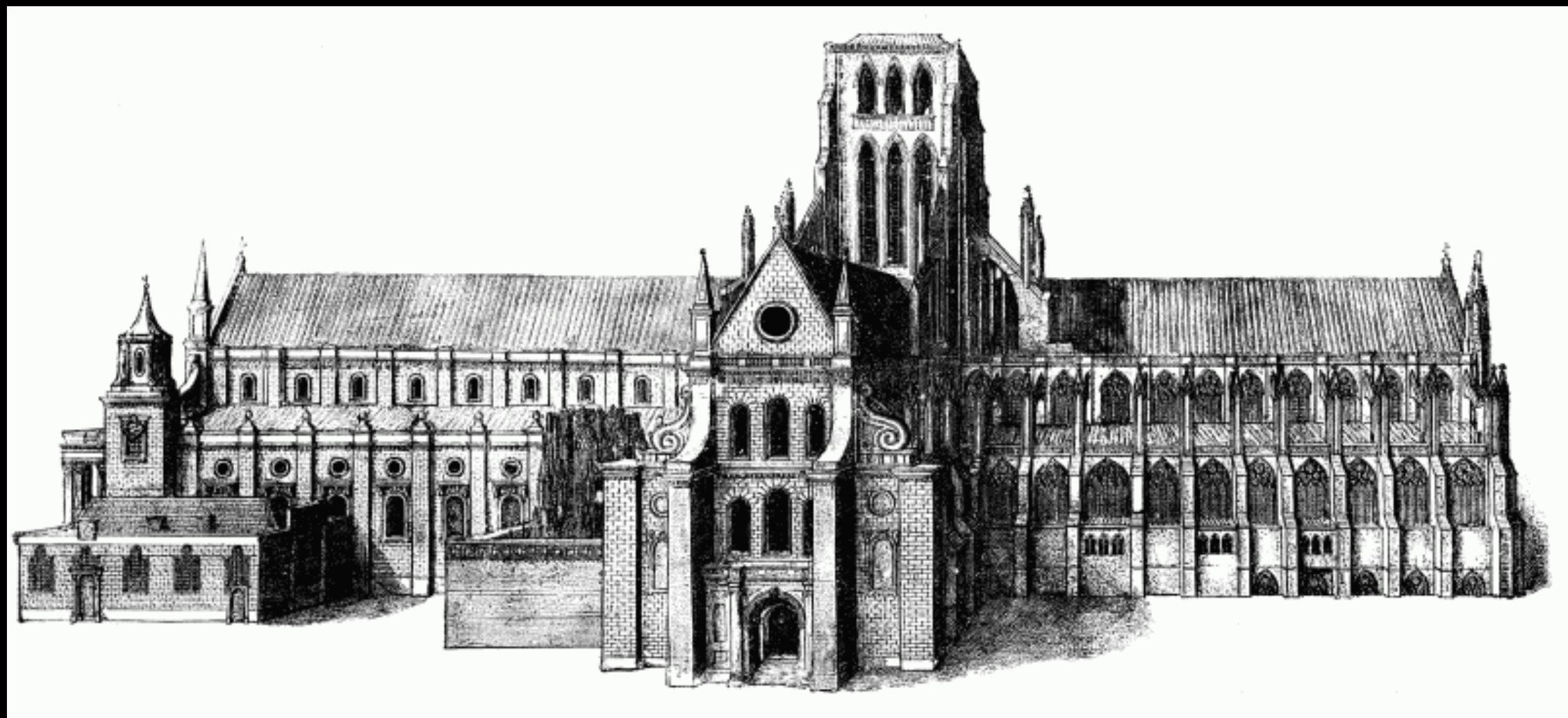
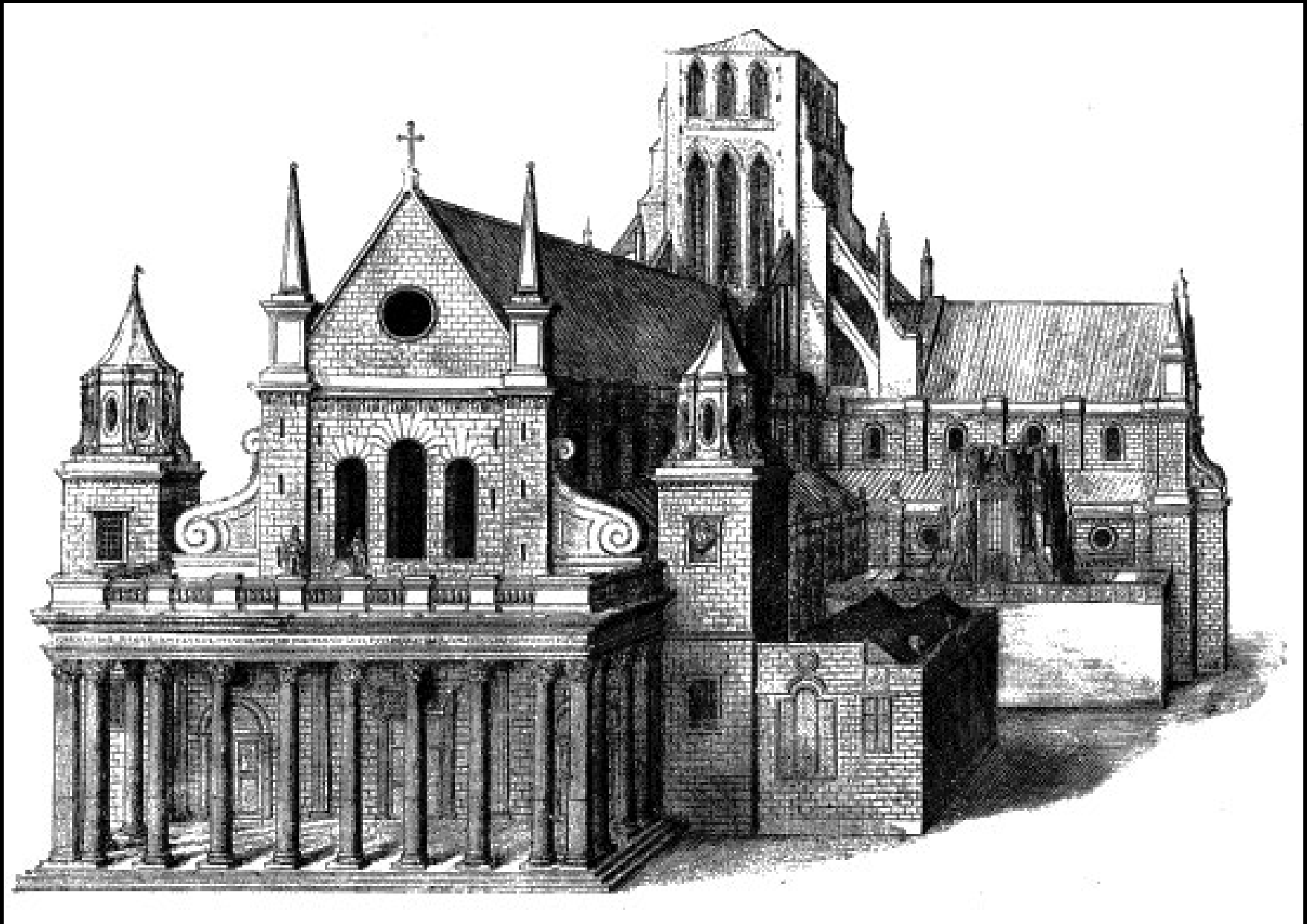


FIG. 2 Whitehall Palace in c. 1635.
