

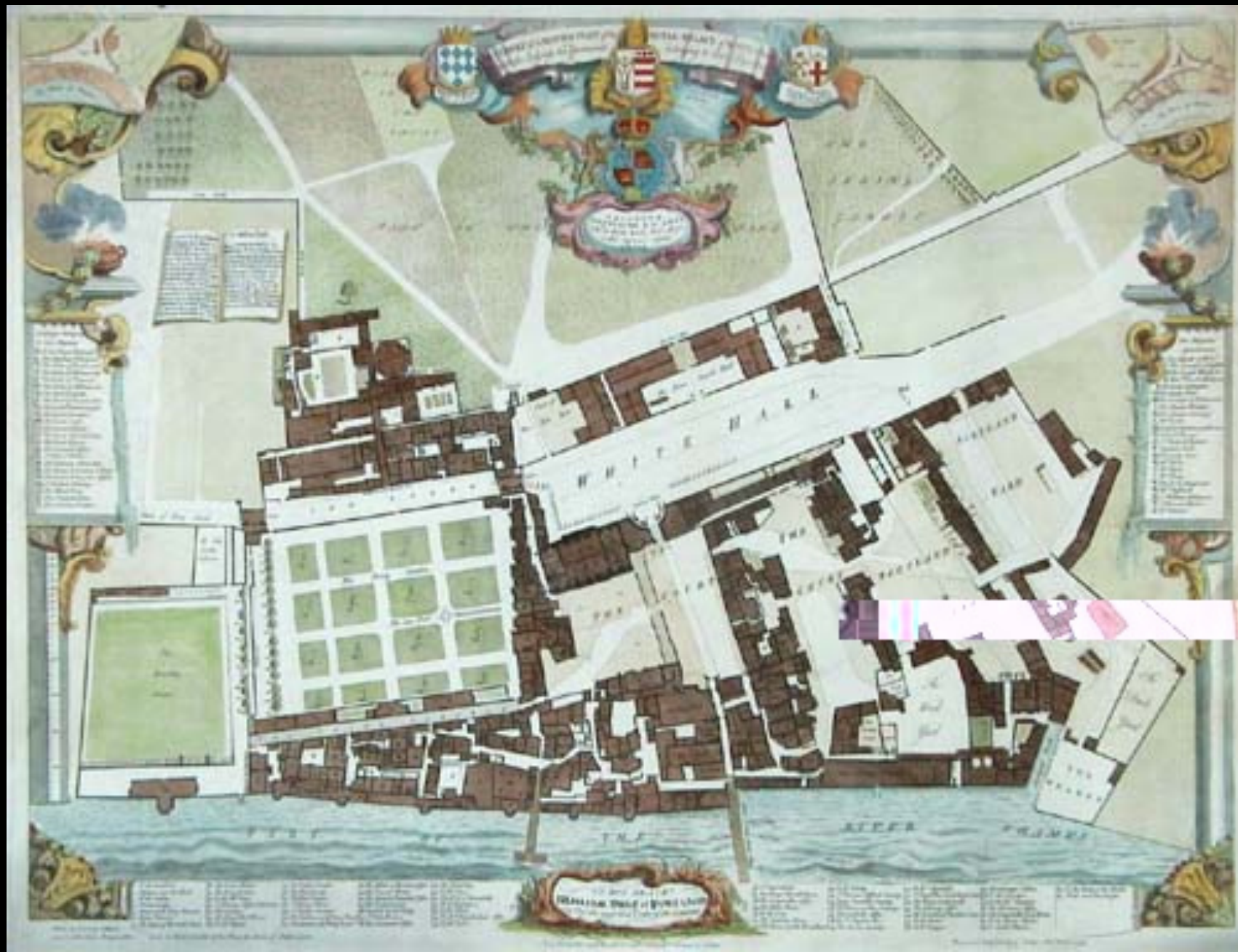

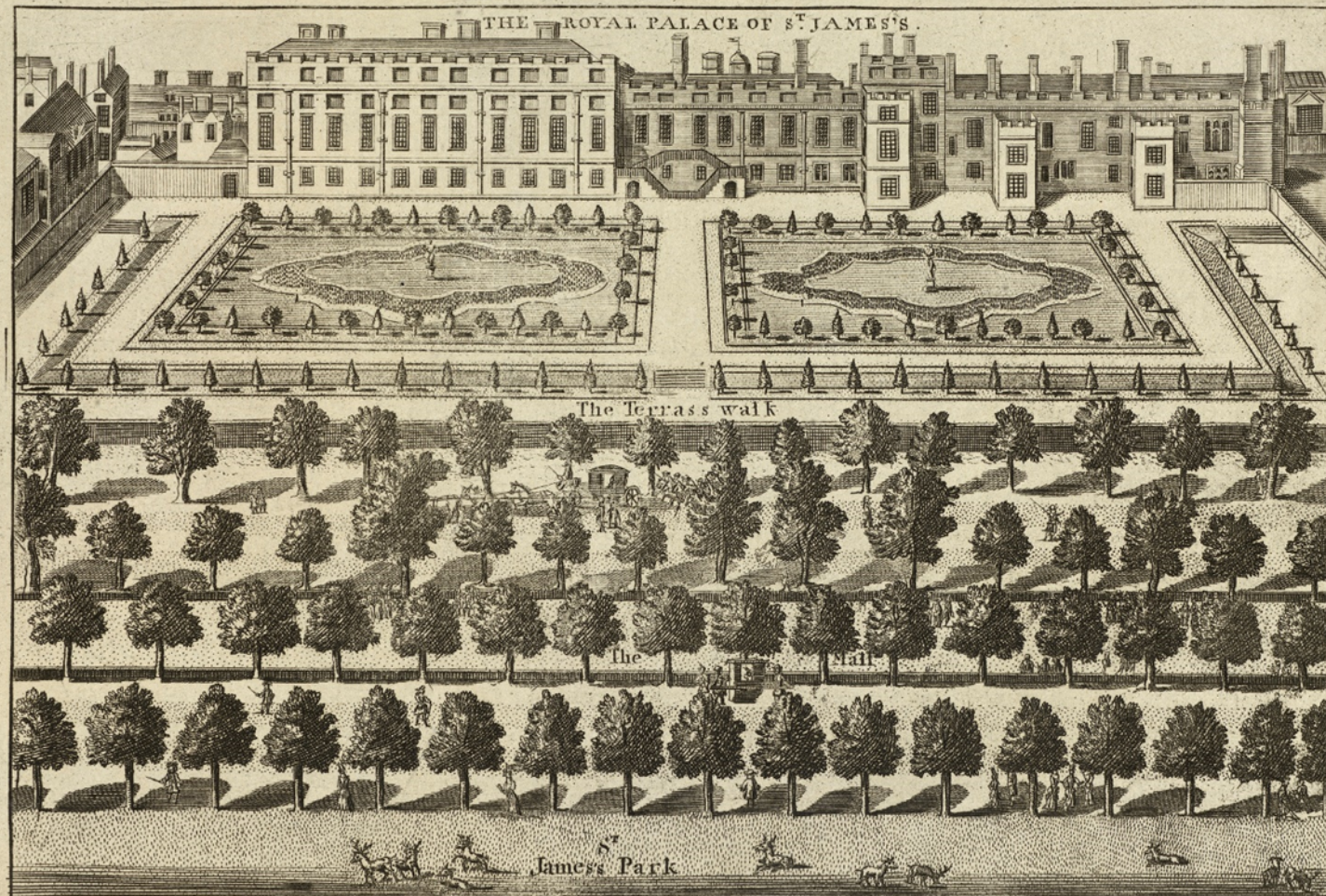






*St. James's Palace and Parts adjacent.*





*This House was antiently an Hospital founded by 5 Citizens of London for 14 Sisters, Maidens, that were Lepers: but being surrendred, to King Henry y 8<sup>th</sup>, he allowed the Sisters Pensions during their Lives, built a goodly Mannour House upon the Site, and enclosed the Ground about it for a Park; it contains many pleasant, Noble, Magnificent, and Beautiful Rooms and Apartments, and since the Burning of Whitehall, has become the only Reception of the Court when in Town.*

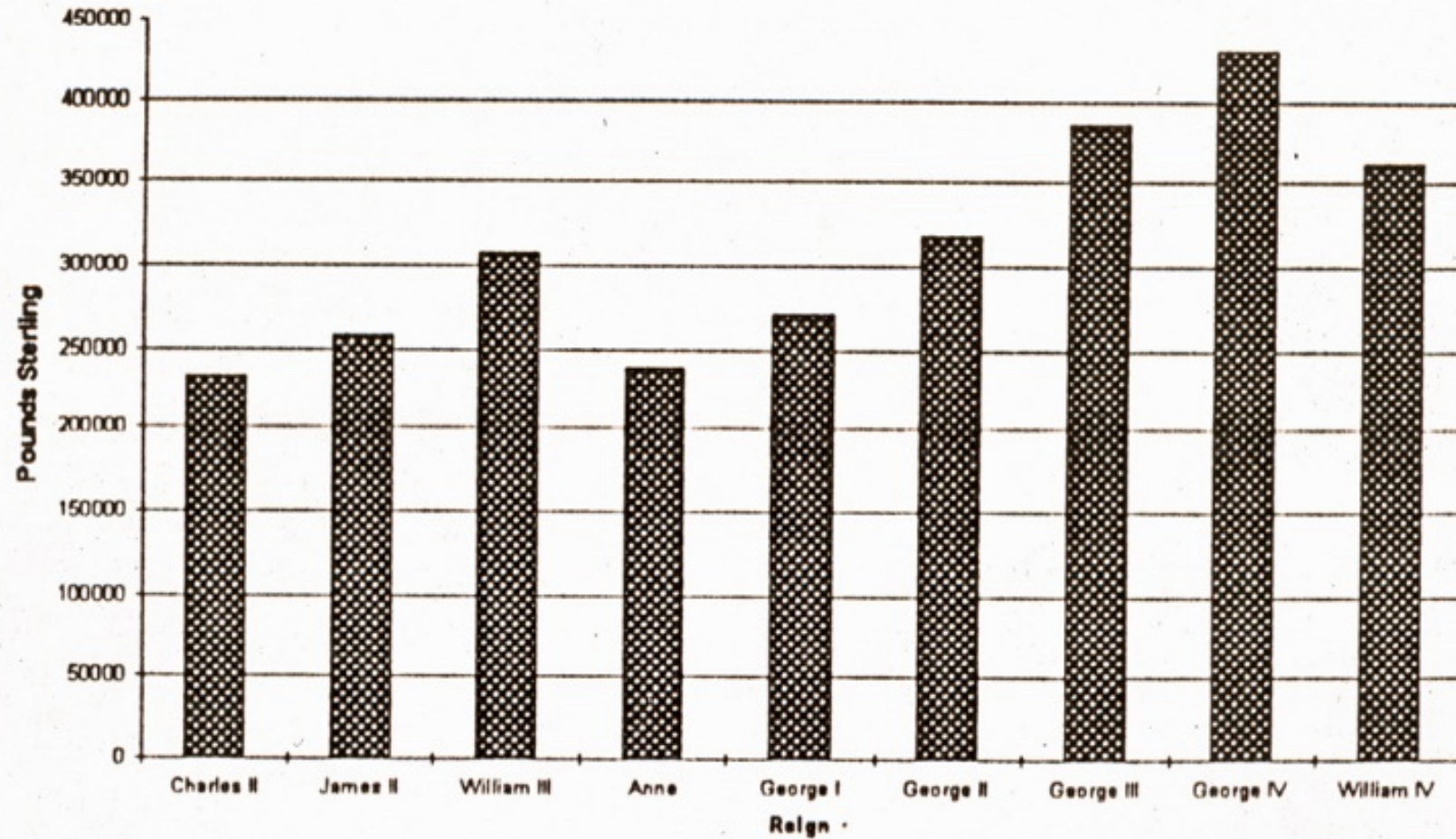

**Average Annual Issues to the Household 1660-1837**





















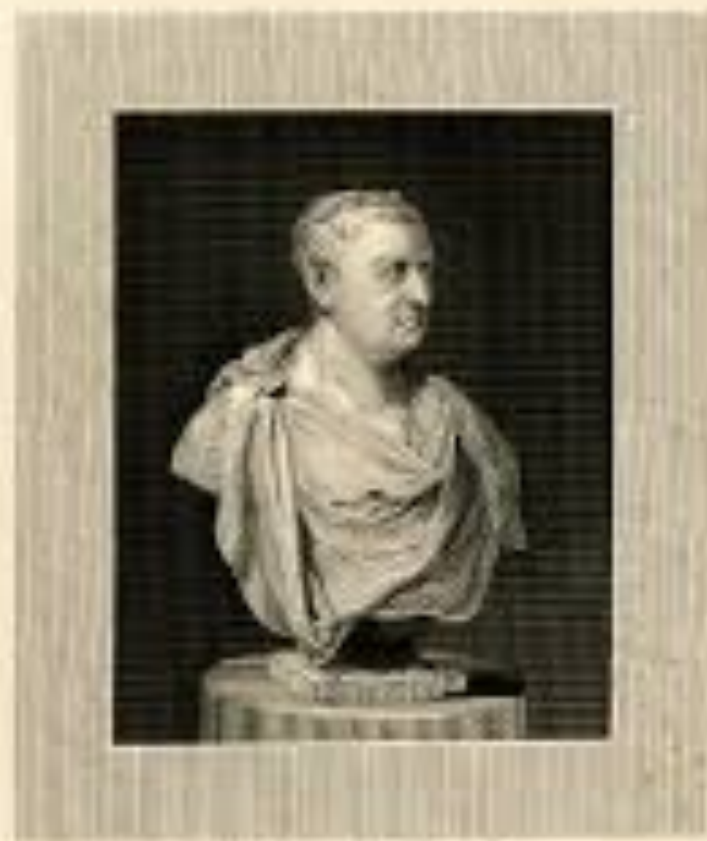
