








Organ Transplantation

the apotheosis of human generosity











Consent

Of the donor Of the donor's family Of the recipient

Opt In

The donor has voluntarily signed up to a donor register whilst able to do so

Opt Out

Everyone is assumed to have given consent, unless they opt out by stating so in advance

The family can still override that consent (after death) by declining to donate the organs after death

What is meant by brain death?


the irreversible loss of all functions of the brain, including the brainstem

Coma Apnoea Lack of brain-stem reflexes No sedative drugs





Removing organs under orders from live ('executed') prisoners







good at all.


I think very few countries have any leverage at all when it comes to what happens inside China and the Chinese Government is absolutely clear that this is not a matter for outside countries'.


