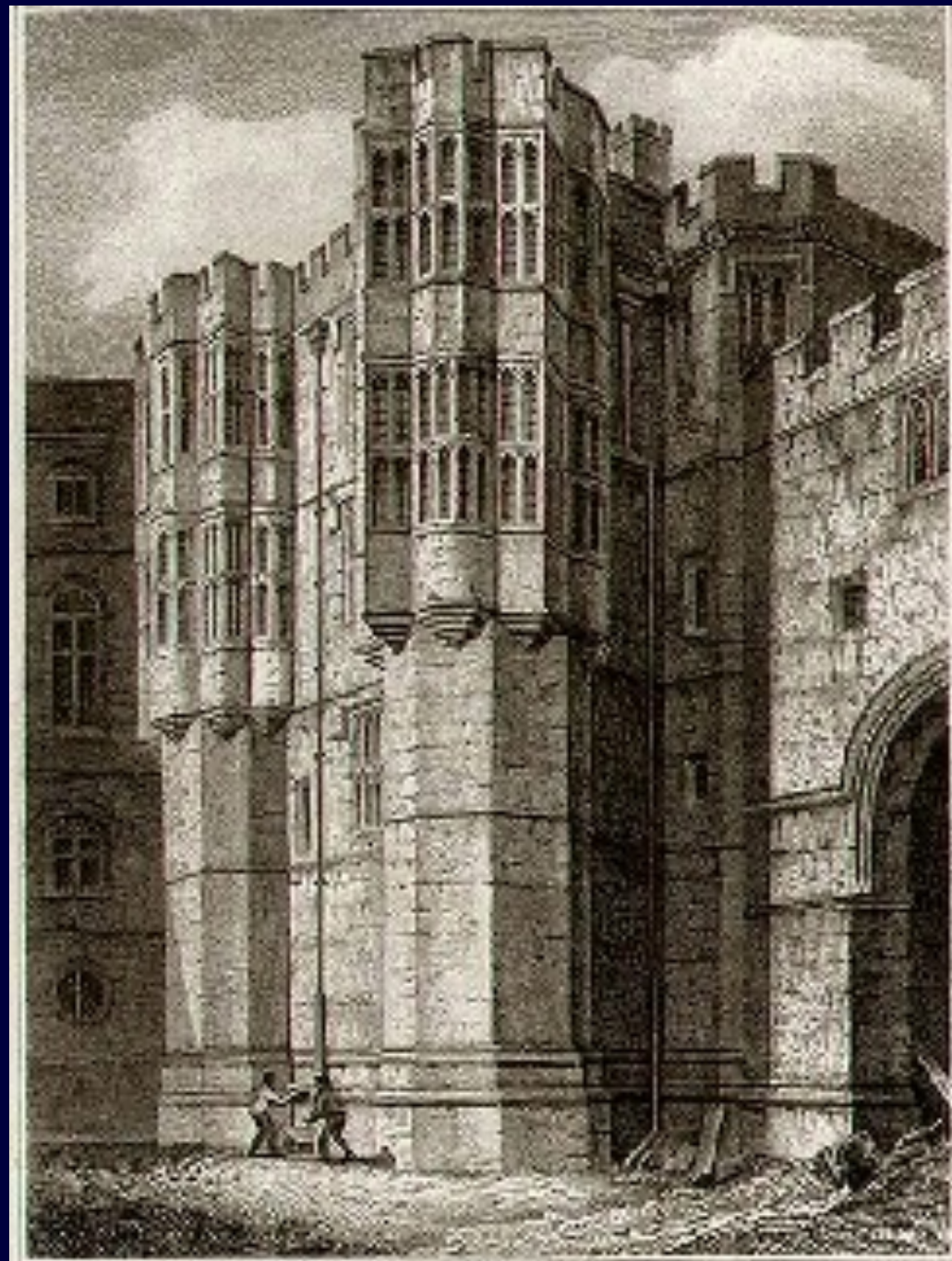

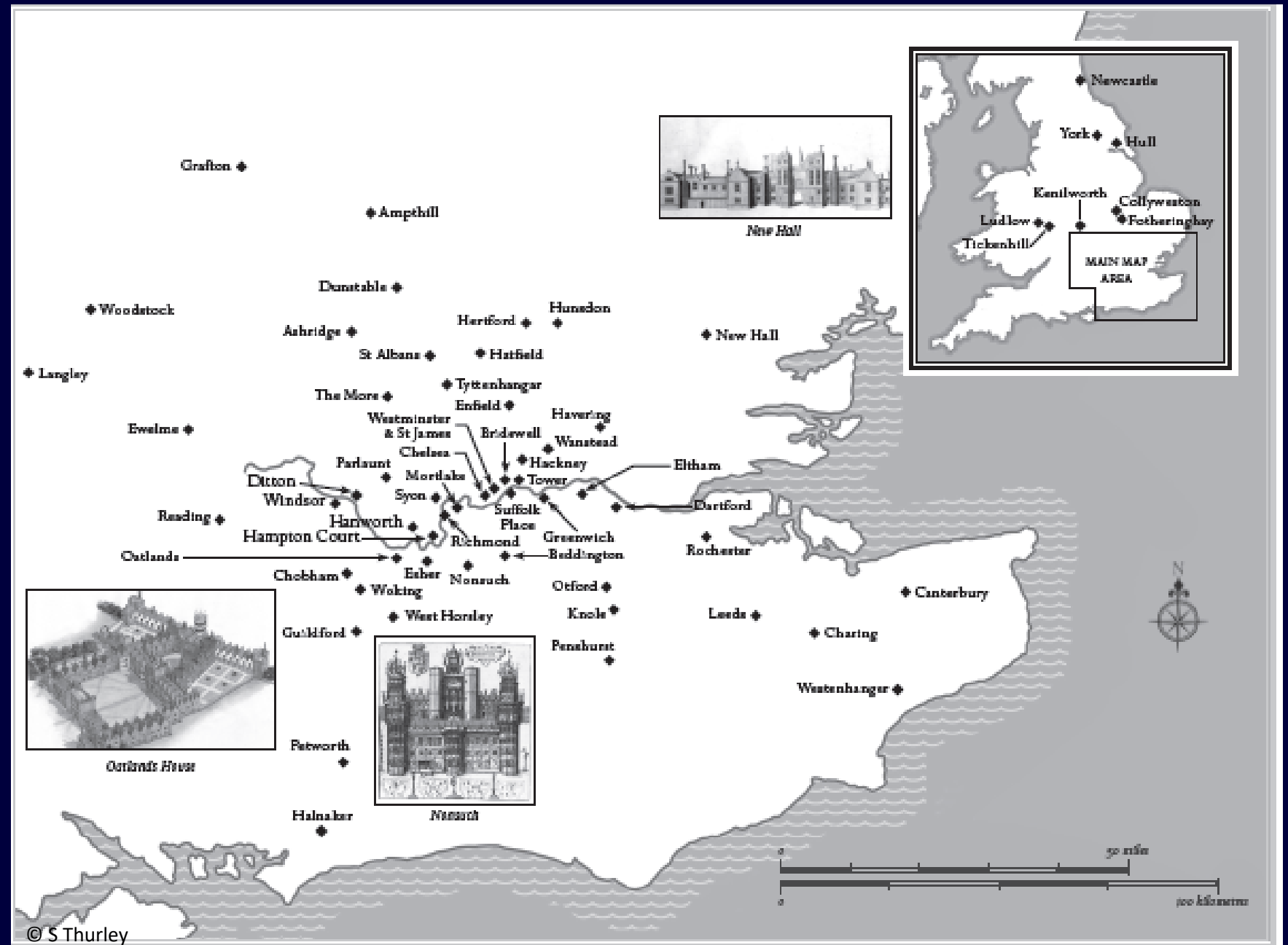

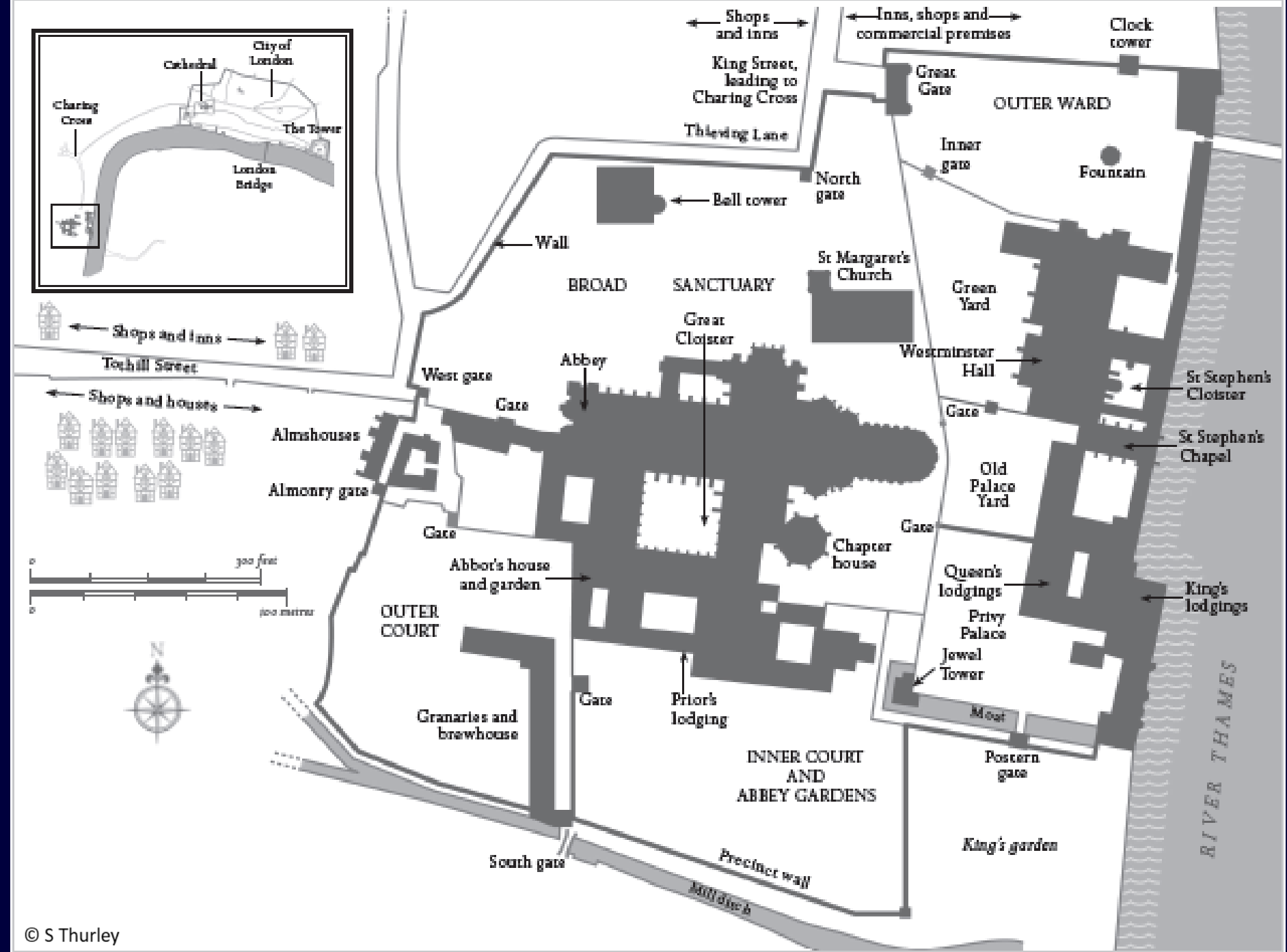






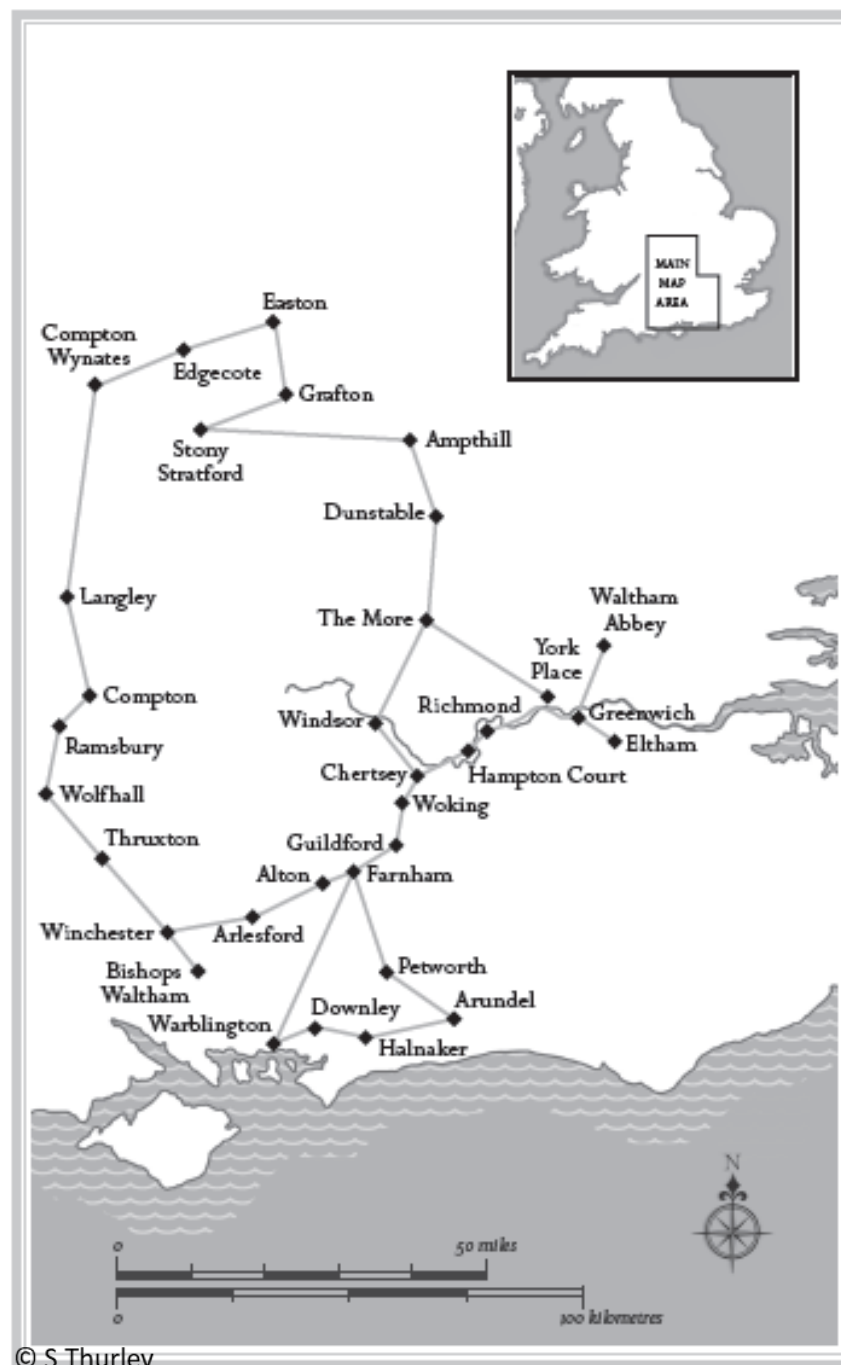






Plan of Westminster Palace. Simon Thurley: from *Houses of Power*

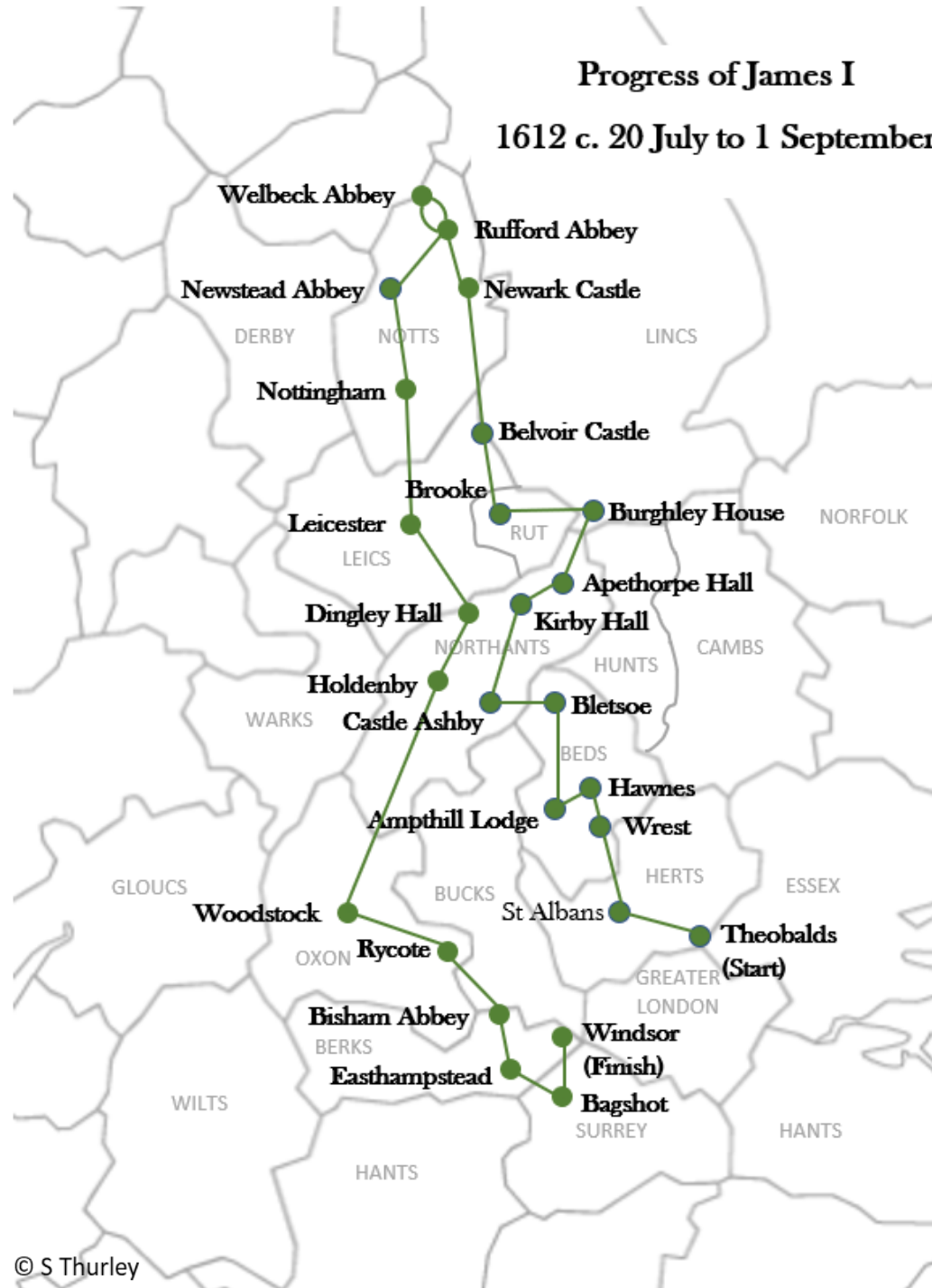


*Queen Elizabeth I's progress

1612 c. 20 July to 1 September



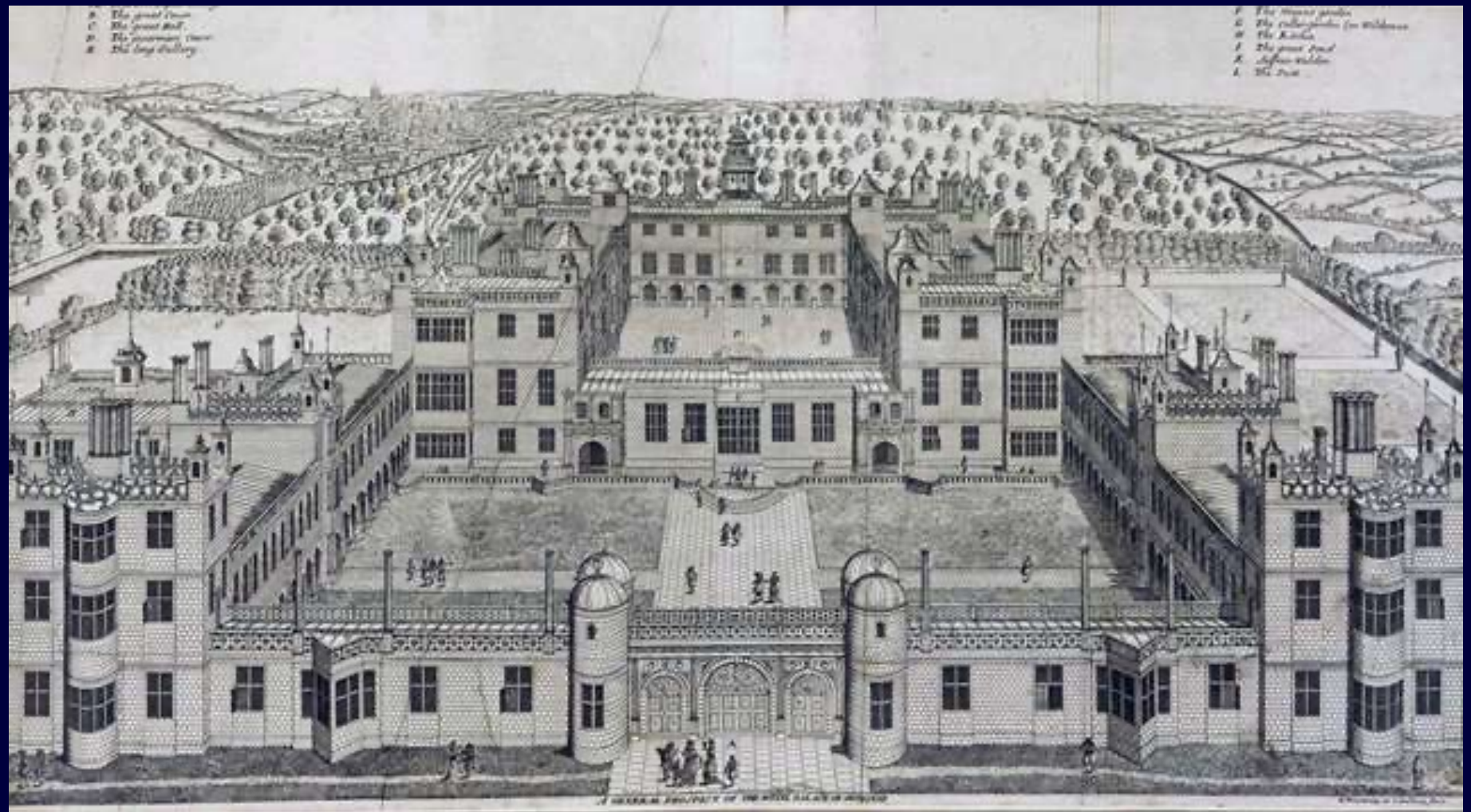

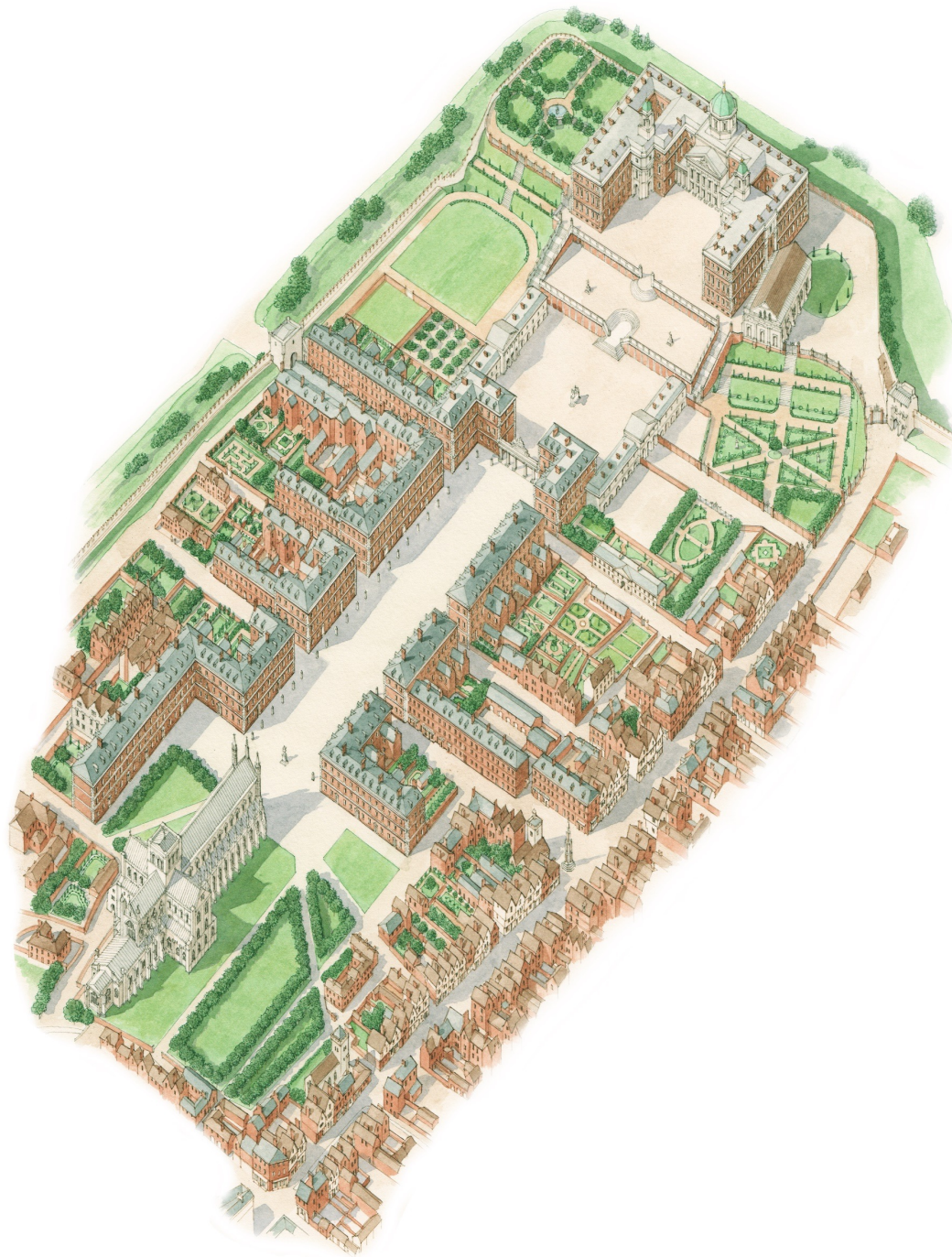




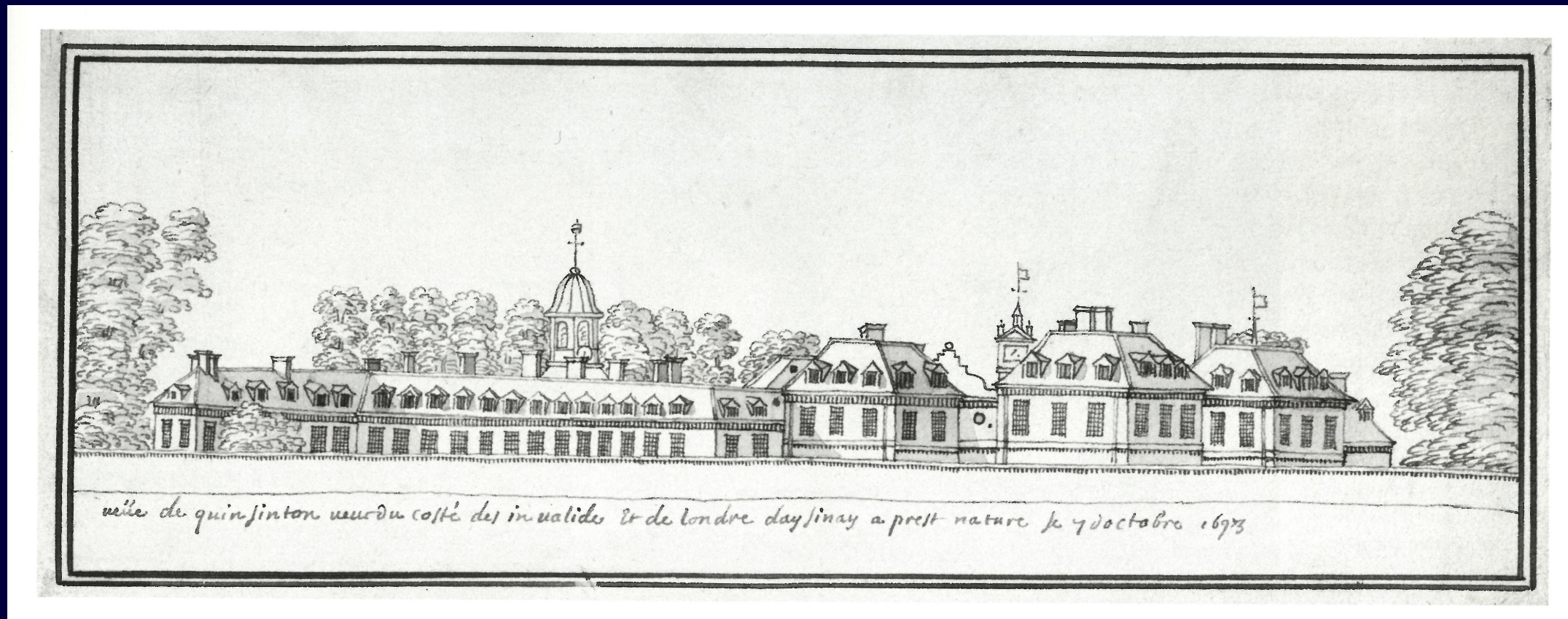
